Policy Statement Regarding Temporary or Permanent Viewing Obstruction of Works of Art in the City's Collection on Public Display

The City's Civic Art Collection represents the city's cultural heritage. Artworks in the Collection are intended for public display for the enjoyment of residents and visitors to the City. The Arts Commission, under the City Charter, has the responsibility to care for and manage the City's Civic Art Collection, and has sole authority over the installation, removal, or alteration or conditions of the public display of the Artwork. The Arts Commission must approve any activity that affects the Artwork under its jurisdiction. This includes, but is not limited to the obstruction of the view of the artwork, alteration of the site conditions that change the context of the Artwork, construction or other activities that potentially could cause damage to the Artwork or require removal from public display.
