3. Discussion. Committee discussion on matters relating to Advisory Committee and Street Artists Program.

Ms. Grant also spoke about individual visitations, particularly with regard to crochet hats with commercial patches.

Dora Greco spoke about her folk and stone jewelry which she makes with her son in law, Ms. Greco also spoke about and exhibited folk and stone pendants. Ms. Greco's son in law, Maurizio Trabuco also presented his and his mother in Law's pendants and bracelets. A patent has been filed for the stone and folk jewelry by Ms. Greco. Both Ms. Greco and Mr. Trabuco expressed concern over other artists copying their folk jewelry designs.

Juan Marin Jimenez spoke about the issues involved with patenting jewelry designs.
