DEFAULT POLICY



Violation of the grant and/or lease agreement

Phase 1: Probation

Grant or lease requirements are knowingly ignored or violated and cannot or will not be rectified within a 6 months window of time

Phase 2: Organization Review

Grantee
violates the
grant and/or
lease
agreement
while on
probation
status

Phase 3: Termination

Review panel recommends termination

Placement directly into Termination status can be triggered by:

- 1. Criminal activity
- 2. Malfeasance
- Noncompliance that results in constituent injury, abuse, or death
