Bed of Trouble is an exhibition that examines ideas around care and kinship.

What are the gestures of care? How do we take care of others? How do we take care of ourselves? How can these actions have a reverberating effect across communities and therefore, be a site for radical possibility. The works in the show so far think about care in different facets: from self care, to care for family and close loved ones, to care for a larger community.

The titles comes from one of the root words for "care", an old Norse word *kör*, which roughly translates to "bed of trouble" or "sick bed."

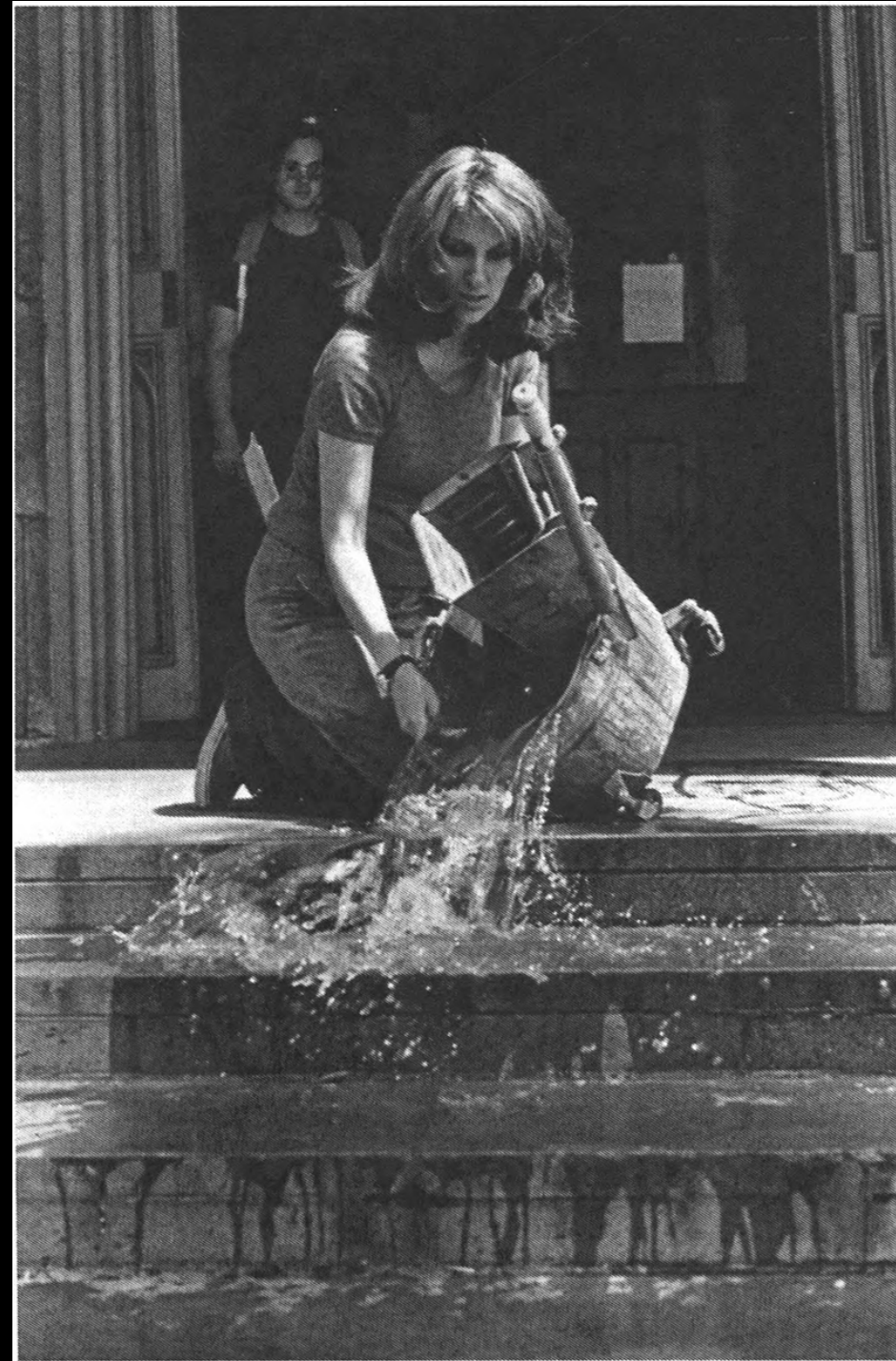
