#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND SCOPE

#### BOARDING AREA A GATE A2 DESIGN CONCEPT

This 4,000SF addition to the boarding area will provide the airport the ability to circulate passengers to/from the gate hold room down to the ramp level where they would board busses to remote aircraft parking positions. This helps expand passenger capacity in the terminal through the added passenger enplanements and deplanements at remote gate-stands.

The design intent for the new bus circulation enclosure is to appear as part of the original building design. By repeating existing materials of exposed concrete, glass storefront, metal panels and using them in similar ways at the addition, the original character and integrity of the boarding area will be maintained. The massing of the new addition will be situated in a corner of the existing footprint. Both the horizontal and vertical datum lines have been preserved and extended on the exterior faces with the window mullions, reveals, and material transitions.

Even though views to this addition are very constricted due to the acute angular geometry of its setting, emphasis has been placed on the exterior elements that are experienced most by the public: the roof as seen from inside the boarding area; the overall massing/facade as seen from the elevated AirTrain tracks; and the canopy and lighting at the curb-side bus loading area.
