

## **Design Narrative**

San Francisco International Airport is creating a 'temporary' facility that provides 9 gates and boaring areas for passengers while adjacent construction of a seperate perminant terminal building is completed. The interim facilities are being designed for an anticipated three year occupancy and combine new airside exterior construction as well as re-use of portions of the existing building envelope (including associated interior modifications).

### **Exterior Character**

The material pallet for new construction consists of formed metal panel cladding (painted finish on galvalume), with exposed fasteners. Two profile sections will be used with profiles running vertically. All trim and flashing will be of similar finish as adjacent panels. New fixed jet bridges to have standard profile metal cladding with color coordinated with new construction. New windows are to be fixed aluminum storefront system with black anodized finish (with clear glazing with exterior frit complying with SF anti bird strike ord.). Existing window assemblies to remain, with exception of removing existing interior film and replacing with complying anti bird strike frit (with similar energy insulating properties).









AIRSIDE ELEVATION














# ENLARGED AIRSIDE ELEVATIONS










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






ENLARGED WALL SECTION AND ELEVATION


