Project area = 0.7 miles from Cesar Chavez to 3<sup>rd</sup> streets


Light/heavy industrial, government and commercial retail activities



12,000 to 23,000 Average vehicles per day

Evans Avenue is part of <u>San Francisco's Vision Zero High Injury</u> <u>Network (HIN)</u>, which highlights that 75% of the city's injuries and fatalities occur on 13% of San Francisco streets.

2015 to 2020 - 81 crashes (vehicle/bicycle/pedestrian) on Evans Avenue between Cesar Chavez and 3rd streets






### Crashes between 2015 to 2020

Muni Stops




## **Evans Avenue Quick-Build Project**

#### **Objectives include:**

Improvements within the project area will provide a greater sense of safety while cycling/walking and support the City's Vision Zero goals.


Typical quick-build type improvements include:

- Road diet (i.e., remove one or two travel lanes)
- Paint, traffic delineators, and street signs
- Parking and loading adjustments
- Traffic signal timing
- Transit boarding islands




## **Evans Avenue Road Diet Options**

Existing – 4 lanes (2 in each direction) with bike sharrows




Option 1 – 3 lanes (1 in each direction plus left-turn lane) with bike lanes




## **Evans Avenue Road Diet Options**

Existing – 4 lanes (2 in each direction) with bike sharrows




Option 2 – 2 lanes (1 in each direction) with buffered bike lanes




## **Evans Avenue Road Diet Options**

#### Option 3 – 2 lanes with protected bikeway & floating parking north/east side
