Fostered: 117 cats, 10 dogs, 4 others (3 guinea pigs, 1 rabbit). Many of these fostered animals went on to be adopted from us, while many other animals were transferred to our adoption partners

ACOs responded to 2,950 emergency calls for service this quarter
