According to a November 3, 2008 article in *The Nation*, "The number of Americans living abroad is still sketchy, since no one has ever done an official count, but the estimates run between 6 million and 7 million."

I don't know if there's been any official count done since the article was written or if there's been any research in this area, but 6-7 million civilian voters (in addition to military voters and their families) are potentially impacted by UOCAVA.
