

Report of Provisional Appointments

This report, requested by the Civil Service Commission (CSC), provides an update on the status of provisional appointments in the City and County of San Francisco as of June 30, 2013.

The chart below graphically compares the provisional counts over time. The Department of Human Resources is proud to report that, as of 6/30/13, the City's provisional employee count continues to trend lower and that the current count of 272 represents a historical low and represents less than 1% of the City's total work force.

The current number of 272 provisional appointments involves 56 different job codes. This is 10 fewer class codes that what was last reported to the CSC twelve months ago, and 7 fewer than what was report to the CSC 6 months ago. This is also significant in that it suggests that the production of eligible lists is doing a better job of keeping pace with the need to hire.

We do find that some titles continue to show some high provisional counts. [See Attachment A which shows the number of provisional employees by classification.] The largest are Medical Evaluations Assistant (47), Home Health Aide (46) and Health Program Coordinator III (18). These three classes alone contain 41% (111) of all of the provisional employees in the City. All of the 53 remaining classes have 12 or fewer provisional employees and 33 of those classes (i.e., 59% of the 56 total classes) have only 1 to 4 provisional employees.

It also should be noted that, of the total 272 positions with provisional employees, 25 will be addressed shortly either because referrals are in progress or because a list has recently been adopted (i.e., 12 for Eligibility Worker, 4 for Patient Care Assistants, 3 for Assistant Storekeeper, 2 for Storekeeper, 3 for Senior Telephone Operator and 1 for Senior Unit Clerk). Further, examinations are already underway or planned to be held within the next 9 months to address another 161 or 65% of the 246 remaining provisional positions.

There are 19 provisional employees who are currently past the three-year term limit in miscellaneous classes. As Attachment B reflects, referrals are already in progress, or will shortly be issued, to address 6 of these positions.

In conclusion, the number of provisional employees dropped precipitously (142) during the last six months (i.e., from 414 to 272). This is attributed in large part to establishing examination project priorities on the basis of provisional counts. In this regard, please note that the Department of Human Resources has published on its website a "Citywide Classification-Based Examination Plan for FY 2013/2014". This report will allow agencies and departments to see what examination projects are targeted for this fiscal year. Hopefully, it will be useful for personnel staffing purposes and reduce the need for provisional hiring.

Recommendation: Adopt the report.
