#### **DISABILITY ACCESS**

Room 416, Fourth Floor, City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place is wheelchair accessible. The closest MUNI stop is on Van Ness Ave. at McAllister Ave. The nearest MUNI bus lines are the 47 and 49 towards Hunters Point. There is accessible street parking around The Library.
