



San Francisco Commission on the Status of Women Resolution Approving the Sole Source Grant Award to ACCESS Reproductive Justice

BE IT KNOWN that the Commission on the Status of Women of the City and County of San Francisco hereby issues and authorizes the execution, by the subscribing Commissioners, of the following commendation:

WHEREAS, the Department on the Status of Women has a new Health & Safety grant for the purpose of ensuring that wraparound services are affordable and accessible for all women and non-binary individuals seeking abortion care in San Francisco and beyond; and

WHEREAS, the Department on the Status of Women desires to provide such a grant to ACCESS Reproductive Justice, a reproductive justice organization committed to working towards social, political, and economic justice through their direct services, community outreach, and wraparound support services for abortion care, to fulfill the Public Purpose of breaking down the barriers of accessibility to abortion care for women, trans people, and non-binary individuals in San Francisco and beyond; and

WHEREAS, the Department on the Status of Women has determined that ACCESS Reproductive Justice is the only entity that can fulfill this Public Purpose because they are the only statewide abortion fund in California that also provides practical wraparound support services.

WHEREAS, Chapter 21G of the Administrative Code ("Chapter 21G") governs the award of grants and provides that granting agencies shall award all grants through an open and competitive process; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 21G.8 of the Administrative Code the Commission on the Status of Women may approve a waiver of the open and competitive process required under Chapter 21G if (1) a competitive process is infeasible or impracticable or (2) the Public Purpose may reasonably be accomplished by one particular Grantee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the San Francisco Commission on the Status of Women approves the sole source justification and the Department on the Status of Women's award of the grant to ACCESS Reproductive Justice.

Grant Solicitation Waiver Instructions

WHEN TO USE: For approval of grant solicitation waivers under [Administrative Code Section 21G.8](#), where:

- A competitive process is infeasible or impracticable
- A Public Purpose may reasonably be accomplished by one particular Grantee

Per the City Purchaser's Administrative Code Chapter 21G Rules and Regulations, this Waiver Form is **not required** for grants awarded in accordance with Administrative Code Sections:

- **21G.3(a)(1):** Grants to a governmental entity for programs, activities, or services that can be practically performed only by that particular entity
- **21G.3(a)(2):** Grants to a specific entity as required to comply with applicable law or contract, or as a result of the requirements of the funding source
- **21G.3(a)(3):** Grants made for improvement to property by a property owner
- **21G.8(c):** Grants to any of the four City-owned community cultural center

INSTRUCTIONS: Complete this Grant Solicitation Waiver Form to request approval to waive the competitive solicitation requirements under Administrative Code Section 21G.8. Provide specific and comprehensive information to justify why the requested grant should be awarded absent a solicitation. Attach appropriate/required supporting documentation.

The Grant Solicitation Waiver Form must be signed by the Granting Officer or their designee. The Solicitation Waiver must be fully approved before the department makes a commitment to the grantee, and before City funds are encumbered. If the Solicitation Waiver request is denied, the department must conduct a competitive process to select the grantee(s).

ACCESS Reproductive Justice is a reproductive justice organization committed to working towards social, political, and economic justice through their direct service, community outreach, and wraparound support services for abortion care. They are the only statewide abortion fund and practical support organization in California. Founded in the Bay Area, ACCESS Reproductive Justice provides direct services to women, trans people, and non-binary individuals in San Francisco and beyond.
- What steps were taken to verify that this is the only entity that can fulfill this Public Purpose? Has the department contacted other entities to evaluate their ability to fulfill the Public Purpose, and if so, describe the entities and explain why they cannot meet the department's needs. The Department has subject matter expertise in reproductive health issues, and held conversations with several reproductive justice, health, and rights organizations to identify where support is needed around access to abortion care. It was determined that ACCESS Reproductive Justice is the only statewide abortion fund in California that also provides practical wraparound support.
