June 3, 2014 Consolidated Statewide Direct Primary Election Canvass
1 % Manual Tally Report

The random selection of precincts for the 1% Manual Tally was done on June 4, 2014 and was opened for public viewing. There are 594 precincts in the June 3, 2014 Consolidated Statewide Direct Primary Election from which to select the 1% of precincts (or 6 precincts). The first six precincts randomly selected are **7317, 7703, 7835, 7848, 7929, and 9245**. These precincts did not cover all the contests for this Election. An additional precinct was then drawn to cover the remaining contest and this is precinct **1102**. The table below shows the precincts and the contests that will be manually tallied in each one.

Additional Precinct

As required by California Elections Code §15360, the 1% Manual Tally was conducted during the period of June 9 to 10, 2014 at Pier 48 Shed B, located on Terry Francois Boulevard, near AT&T Park. The site is the Department’s secured storage facility.

After the votes were manually tallied for each precinct, by 4-man teams composed of Department of Elections’ staffs, the results of the count were compared with the semifinal official canvass results per contest per precinct. The comparisons showed that all of the manual counts for both the precinct ballots (PCT) and vote-by-mail (VBM) ballots matched the machine counts for every contest in all of the precincts selected.
