**Table 1. Challenged VBM, Historical**

**Table 1 Notes:**

“Total Ballots” means total counted ballots (for the counter card, usually Card 1). “VBM” means total counted vote-by-mail envelopes (i.e. not including challenged). “Challenged” means VBM envelopes not counted (e.g. due to signature mismatch). “% Challenged” means Challenged / (VBM + Challenged). In each election we used the counter card instead of the “highest” card for consistency in the historical comparison.

**Table 2 Notes:**

“Total Ballots” means total counted ballots (for the counter card, usually Card 1). “Provisional” means total counted provisional envelopes (i.e. not including rejected). “Rejected” means envelopes not counted (e.g. due to voter not registered). “% Rejected” means Rejected / (Provisional + Rejected). In each election we used the counter card instead of the “highest” card for consistency in the historical comparison.
