Dear President Donaldson,

The 2017-2018 Civil Grand Jury will release an investigative report entitled, "Open Source Voting in San Francisco" to the public on Friday, June 29, 2018. Enclosed is an advanced copy of this report. Please note that by order of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court, Hon. Teri L. Jackson, this report is to be kept confidential until the date of Release (June 29, 2018).

California Penal Code §933 (c) requires a response to be submitted to the Presiding Judge no later than 60 days. California Penal Code §933.5 states that for each finding in the report, the responding person or entity shall indicate one of the following: (1) agree with the finding; or (2) disagree with it, wholly or partially, and explain why.

Further, as to each recommendation, your response must either indicate:

1. That the recommendation has been implemented, with a summary of how it was implemented;
2. That the recommendation has not been, but will be, implemented in the future, with a timeframe for implementation;
3. That the recommendation requires further analysis, with an explanation of the scope of that analysis and a timeframe for discussion, not more than six months from the release of the report; or
4. That the recommendation will not be implemented because it is not warranted or reasonable, with an explanation.
