

Alesandra Lozano Bio

Alesandra Lozano is the Voting Rights & Redistricting Program Manager at California Common Cause where she leads CCC's work on voter protection, voting rights and redistricting legislation, election administration, and local redistricting. Alesandra is based in San Francisco and comes to California Common Cause with over a decade of organizing and advocacy experience, and expertise in voting rights policy.

Alesandra joined the California Common Cause team in late-2021 and led a team of three staff and four contractors to monitor the redistricting processes in over 60 local jurisdictions. In those cities, counties, and school districts the Common Cause team provided: (1) assistance on legal requirements pertaining to local redistricting and outreach best practices, (2) oversight of redistricting hearings and advocacy to address issues identified, and/or (3) close partnership with community-based partner organizations. Alesandra's team recorded 328 instances of direct assistance CCC provided to local organizations and jurisdictions during the 2020-2021 redistricting cycle. This included work in 15 Central Valley jurisdictions, five San Diego-area jurisdictions, 24 LA County jurisdictions, and San Francisco.
