Election Numbers of Interest

Related to election observation and future planning, below are some election numbers I think would be useful for the Commission to have access to when reviewing future elections. Some of these I mentioned verbally at the May meeting, so I'm writing them down here for convenience and future reference.

The first set of numbers relate to understanding <u>how and what methods people are using to</u> <u>vote</u>, and the second set of numbers relate to remakes.

How People are Voting

Vote-by-mail (VBM)

Of the VBM voters-

- How many submitted / sent their vote-by-mail ballot—
 - By mail (US postal service)
 - By drop box
 - By voting at a Voting Center (e.g. City Hall)
 - By dropping off at a polling place on Election Day
 - Are there any other categories of VBM return not listed above?
- How many submitted a ballot from the Accessible Vote-by-Mail (AVBM) System?

Ballot-marking Device (BMD)

Of the voters that used one of the Department's BMD's, how many used it-

- At a polling place on Election Day
- At a Voting Center (e.g. City Hall)
- During emergency voting (e.g. hospitalized or homebound voters)
- Are there any other BMD categories not listed above?

Miscellaneous (emergency and fax)

- How many used emergency voting (e.g. hospitalized or homebound voters)?
- How many sent their ballot by fax (e.g. Military and Overseas Voters)?

Ballot Remakes

- How many voters had one or more of their ballot cards remade?
- How many ballot cards were remade in all?
- How many cards were remade due to the ballot being damaged in some way?
