Is there construction that will impact my outdoor event?

Be aware of upcoming construction projects on specific streets by using free online tools from DataSF. You can search by street name and view an upcoming project's address, type, permit status, contact, and more.

How to search and sort the data set:

- 1.) In the upper right corner, where it says "Find in this Dataset," type the name of a specific street you want to look up. (Example: "Howard") Hit the Enter key and view search results.
- 2.) Scroll to the right to view all the details. Example: "BP FILED" = Building Permit Filed.
- 3.) Click the "Export" tab in the upper right corner to download the data in Excel, CSV, or other format.
