### Proposed Ordinance for a Cannabis Event Permit in SF

On Jan. 29th, Supervisors Rafael Mandelman and Vallie Brown introduced an ordinance to the SF Board of Supervisors that would establish a **Cannabis Event Permit** for temporary events with cannabis sales and consumption. If approved, this would provide the SF Office of Cannabis with procedures to regulate cannabis events and give local approval of these permits before final sign-off from the state.
