#### **Proposed Ordinance for a Cannabis Event Permit in SF**

On Jan. 29th, Supervisors Rafael Mandelman and Vallie Brown introduced an ordinance to the SF Board of Supervisors that would establish a **Cannabis Event Permit** for temporary events with cannabis sales and consumption. If approved, this would provide the <u>SF Office of Cannabis</u> with procedures to regulate cannabis events and give local approval of these permits before final sign-off from the state.
