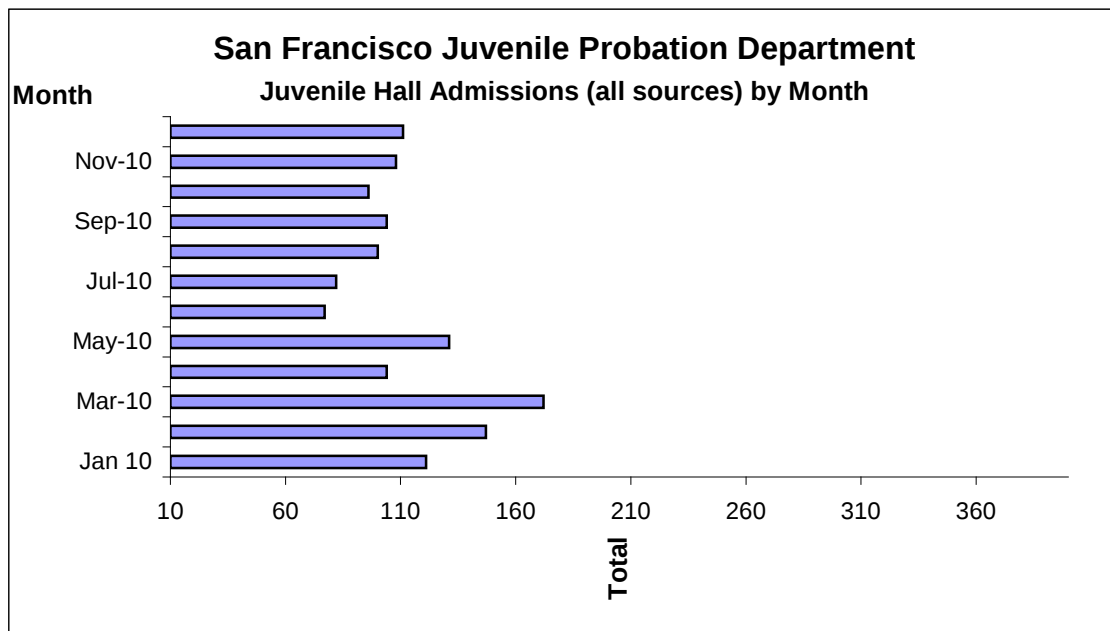
Bay Area Resident Juvenile Hall Comparison Over/Under Capacity on October 29th, 2010

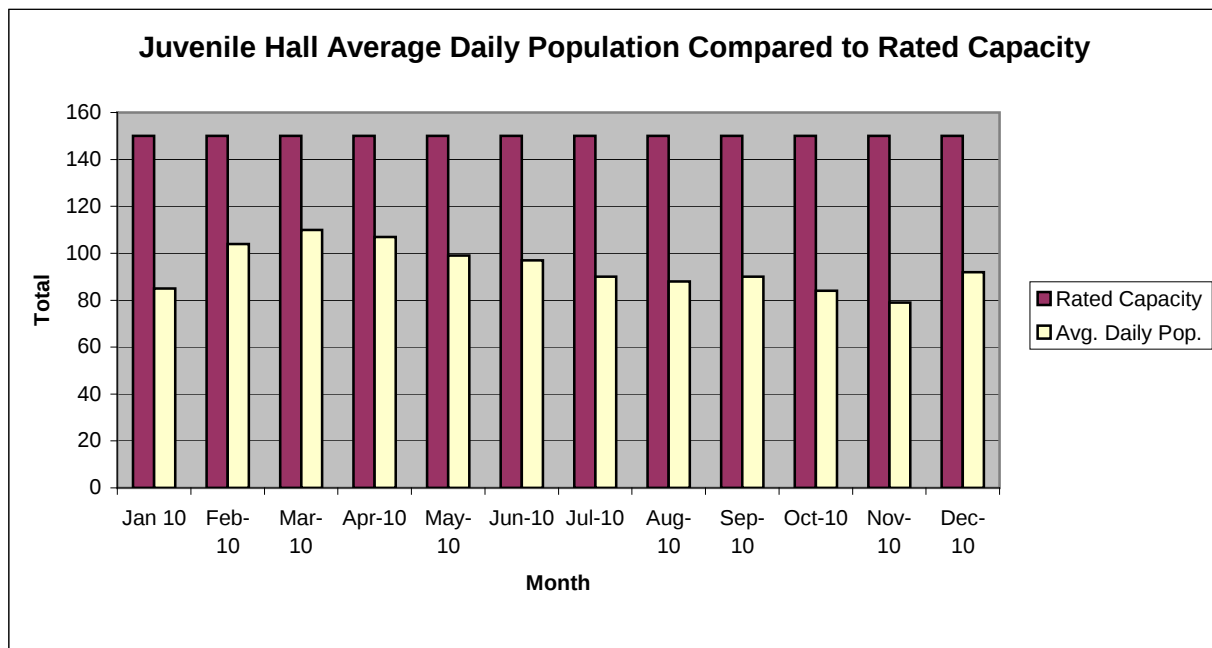

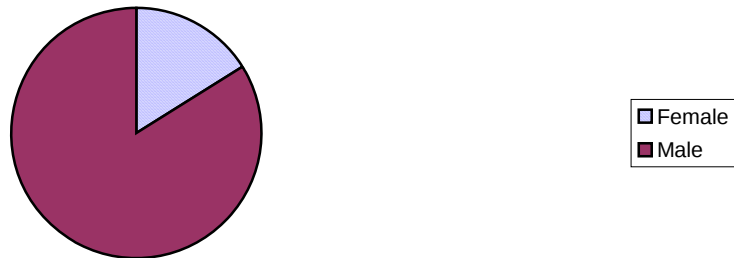

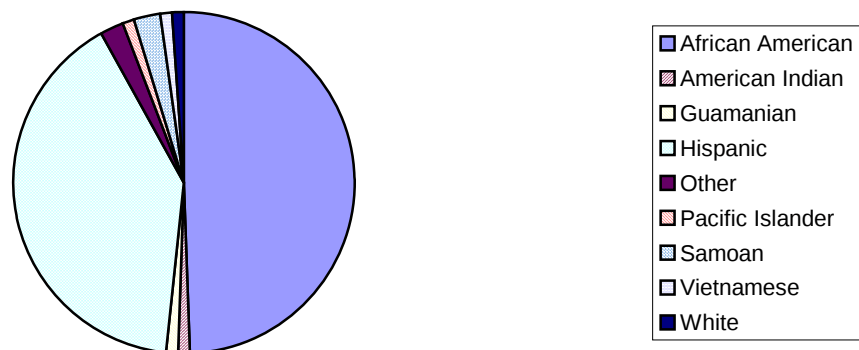

Of Juvenile Hall Detainees on 12/31/10 by Gender**

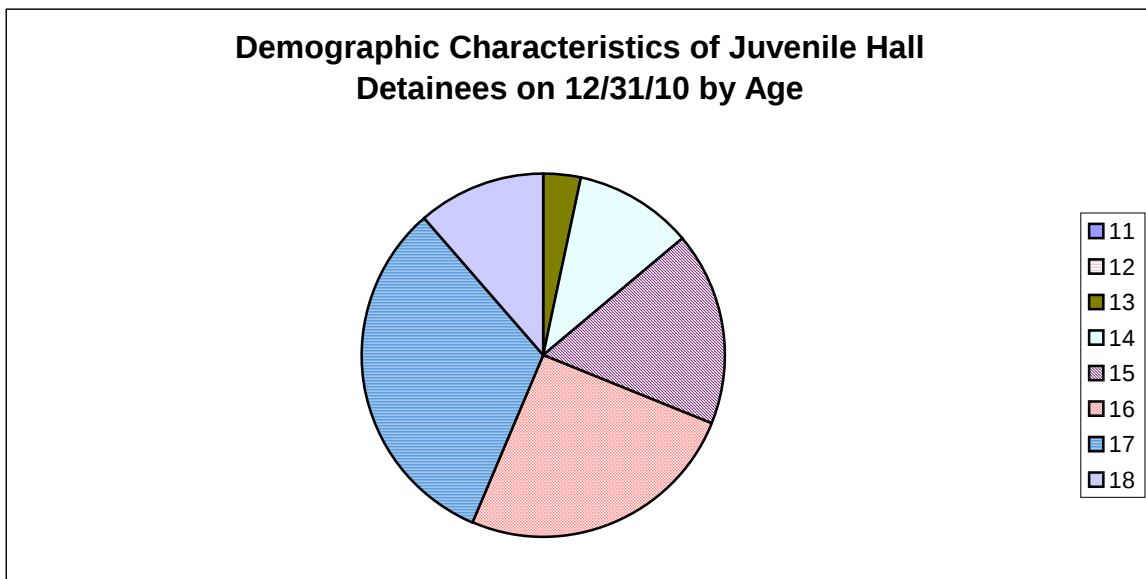

12/31/10 by Race**

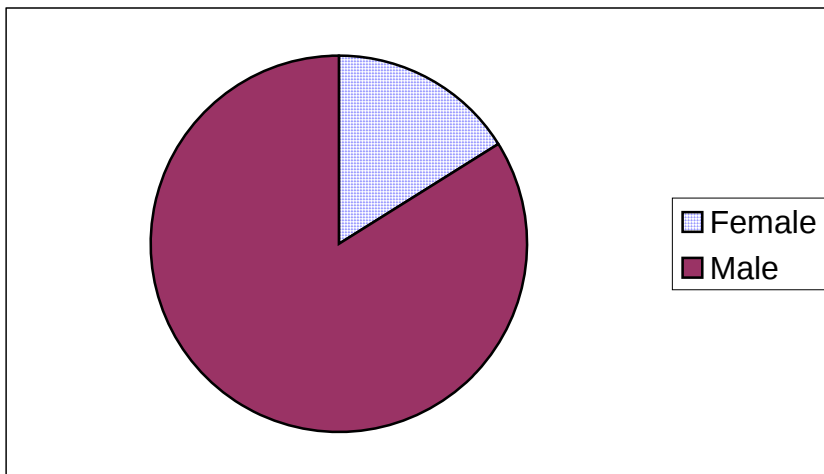

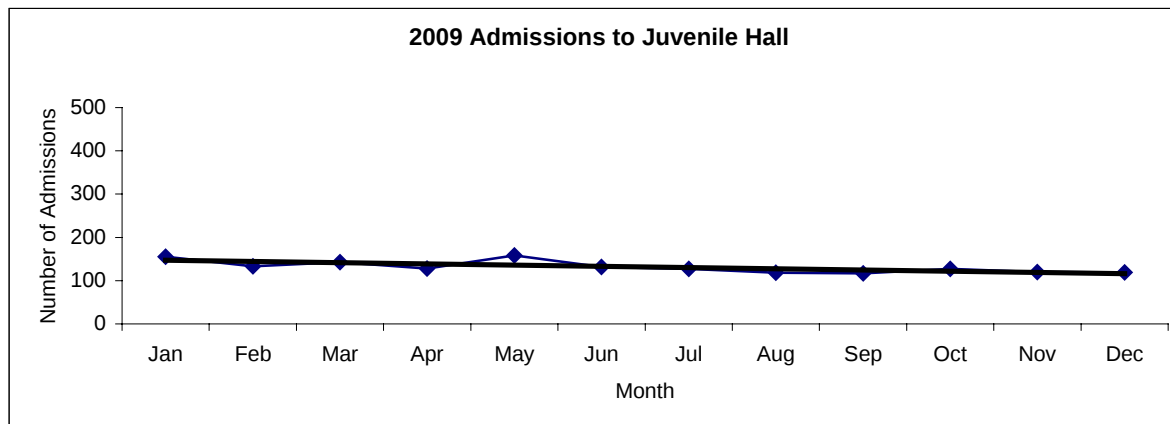
