
Out-of-Home Placement¹ Commitments of 602's Calendar Year 2011


Bay Area Resident Juvenile Hall Comparison Over/Under Capacity on April 1st, 2011




San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department **Probation Referrals (all sources) By Month** (2008-2010)













San Francisco Juvenile Probation Juvenile Hall Admissions By Month (2008-2010)













