

LOG CABIN RANCH PROGRAMATIC UPDATE

The Weekend Construction class started July 7, 2007. This is a joint collaborative with an actual Construction school, Department of Public Works and Juvenile Probation. Class is scheduled to meet Saturdays for 4 hours and Sundays for 3. Due to the dedication of instructor, Keevin O'Brien, the classes often meet for much longer.

The construction class began with an enthusiastic start. Residents were immediately engaged in cosmetic repairs coupled with starting the certified curriculum produced by the National Center for Construction Education and Research.

Despite numerous willing participants, the class has been limited to approximately 10. The program has kept its promise to provide 50% classroom instruction and 50% hands on experience.

Building decks and benches have been repaired as well as painted. Residents proudly point out a bench that has been built by them from scratch (w/no help from the teacher they insist). Esteem has been positively affected. In addition, upon completion of this 40-hour plus course, residents' can- upon graduation from the Ranch- automatically begins a 6-month construction program with DPW. Upon completion of the 6- month program, they have a reserved spot in the 2- year Apprentice program, which provides a stipend and pays for essentials like union dues.

Effective September 10, 2007 our 8-week rotation vocational classes sponsored by Turning Heads started. 3 classes, Barber Shop, Youth Sounds (making music via computers) and Construction are being offered to 20 plus youth.

Other programming (YCD, OTTP, Real Fathers, Writers Corp & Life Skills) remains in effect or will be re-starting by next month.

Beginning in October, Each One Reach One will begin fulfilling a grant to teach the residents how to write plays/skits, which will then be acted out by professional actors.
