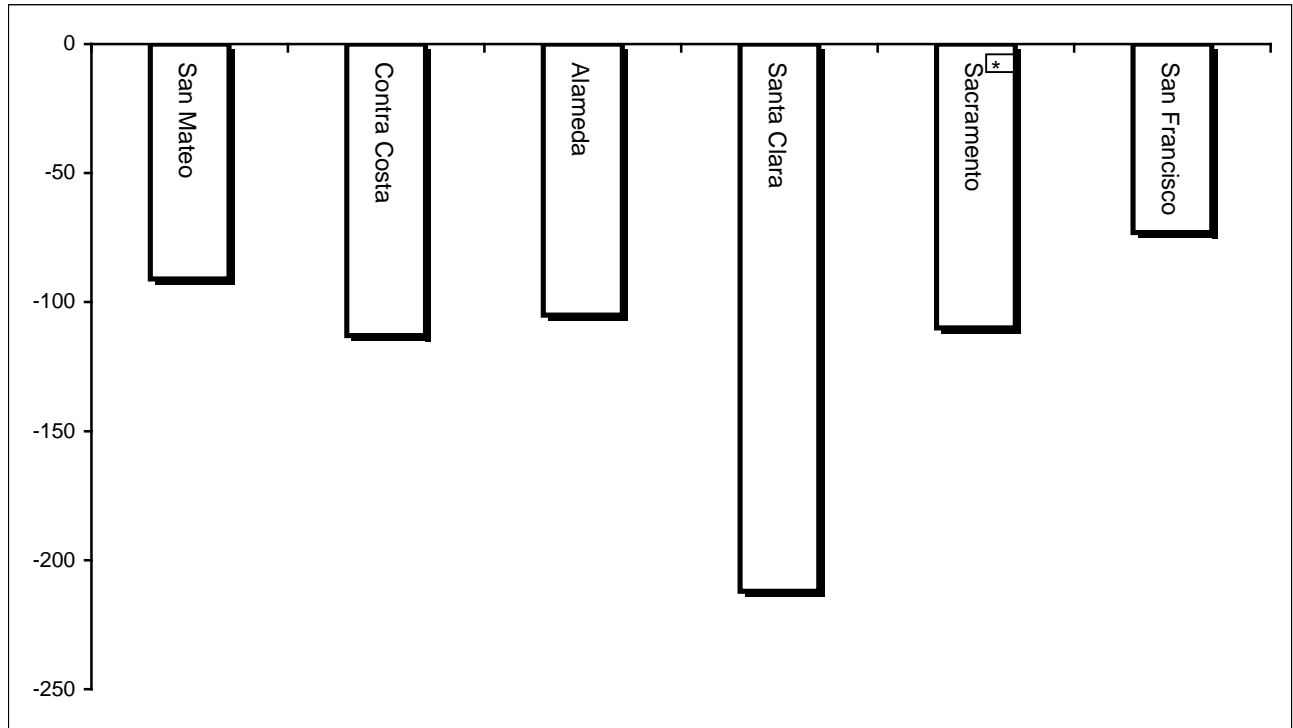

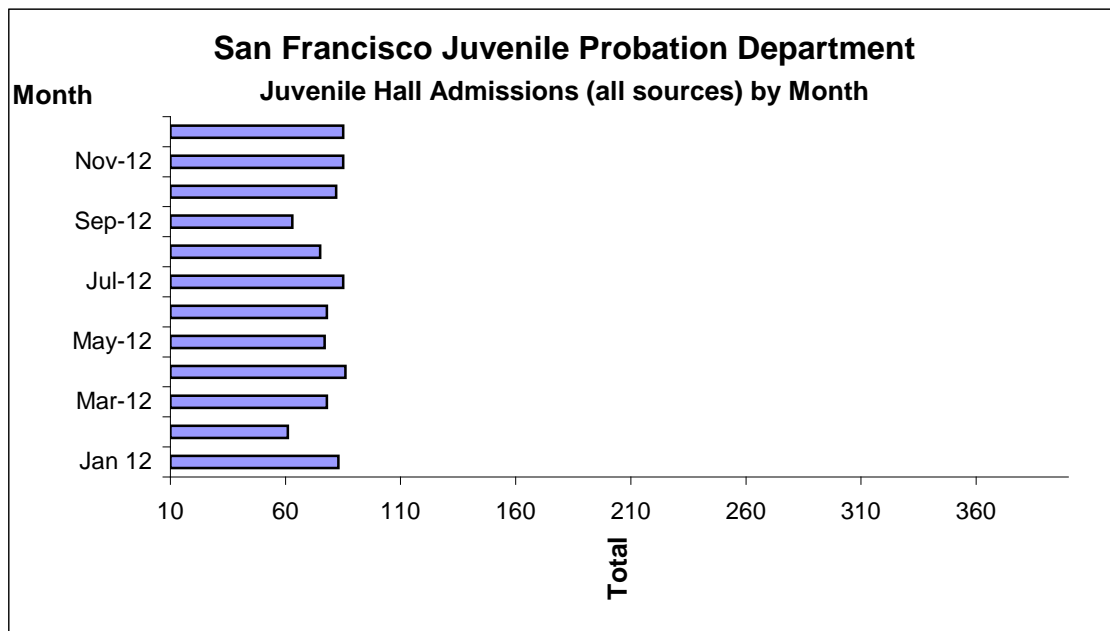

Of Juvenile Hall Detainees on 12/31/12 by Gender**

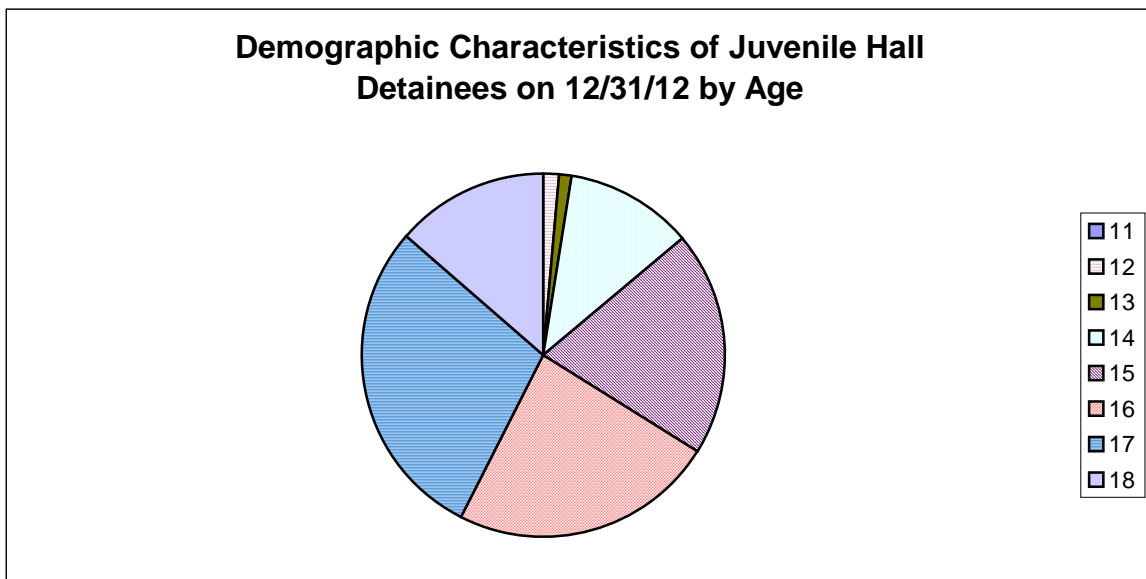

12/31/12 by Race**

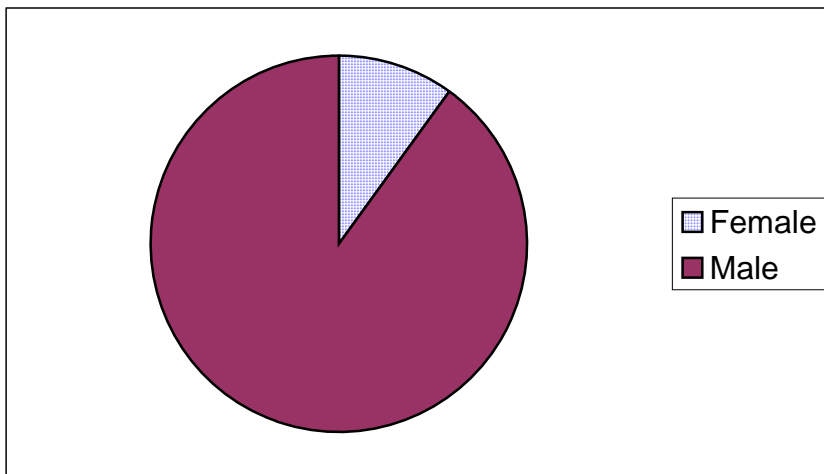

(2008-2010)

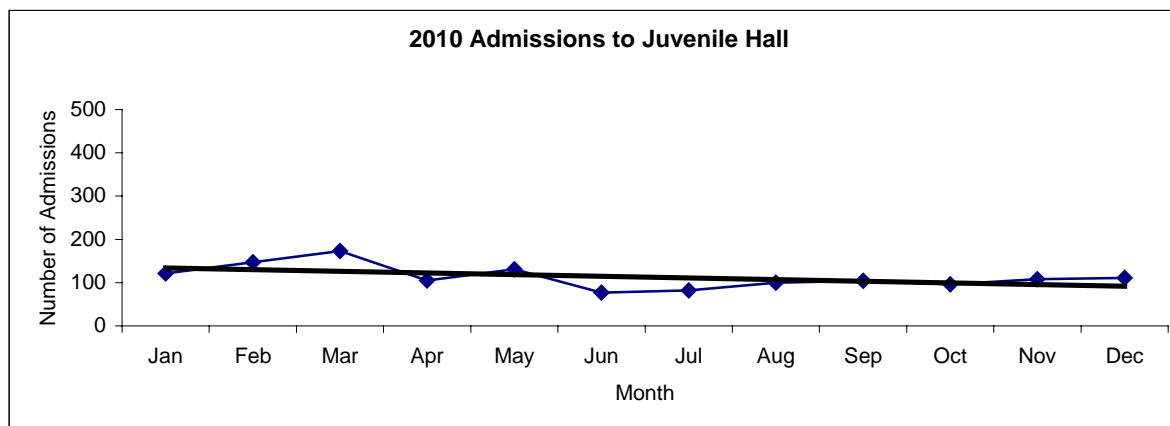

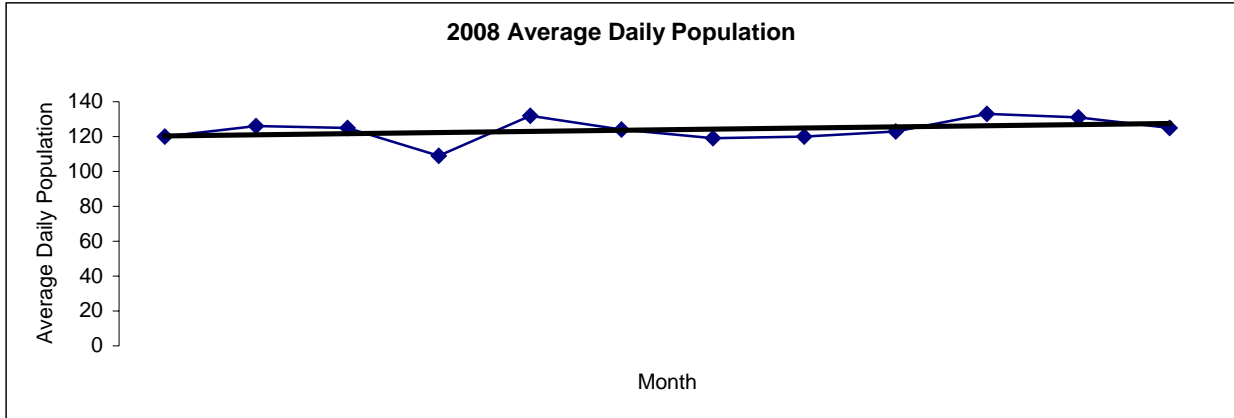

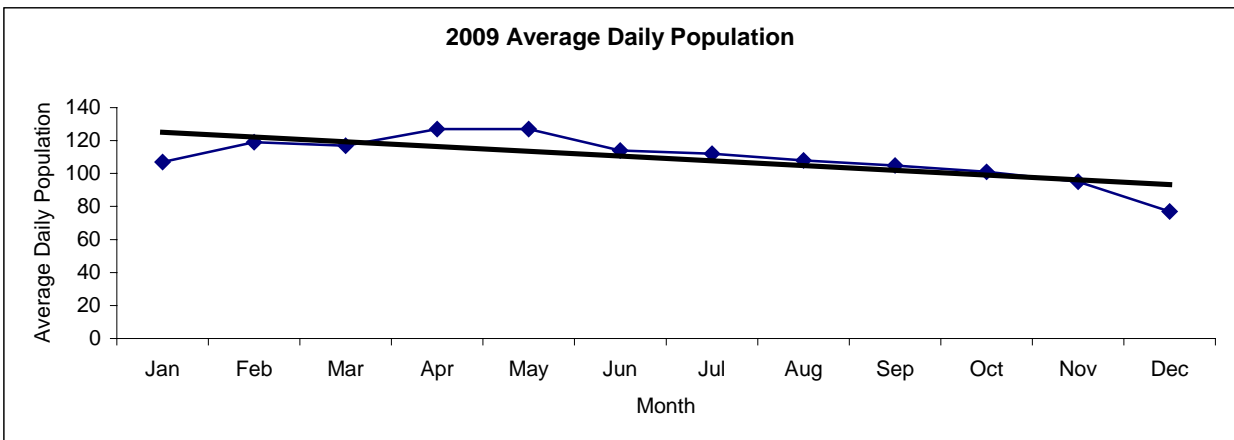
