Of Juvenile Hall Detainees on 11/30/12 by Gender**

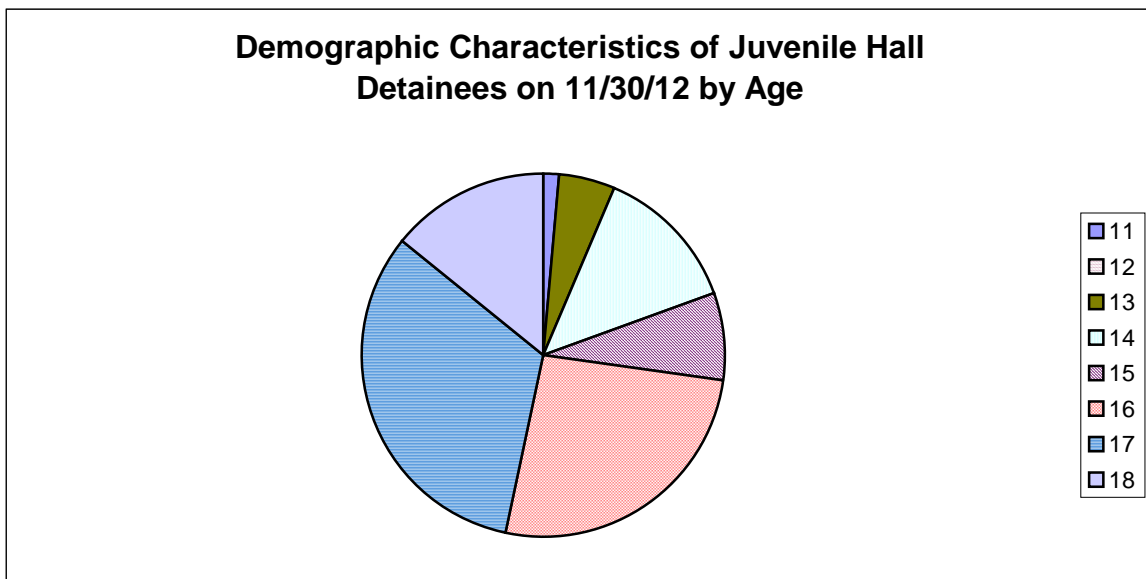

11/30/12 by Race**

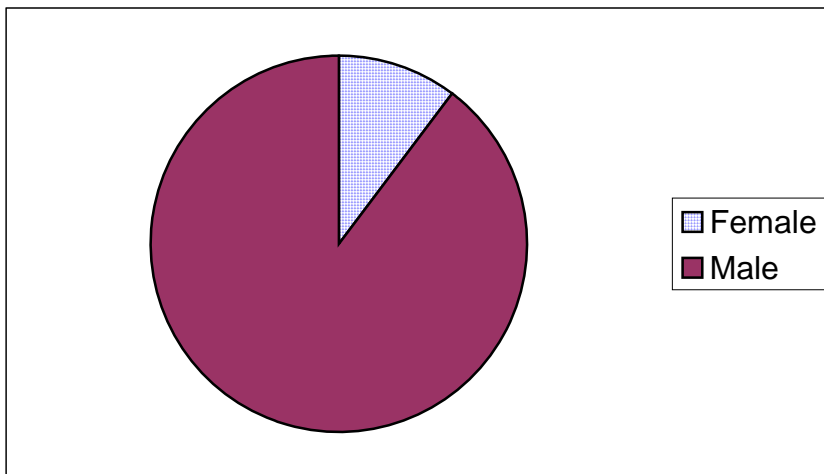

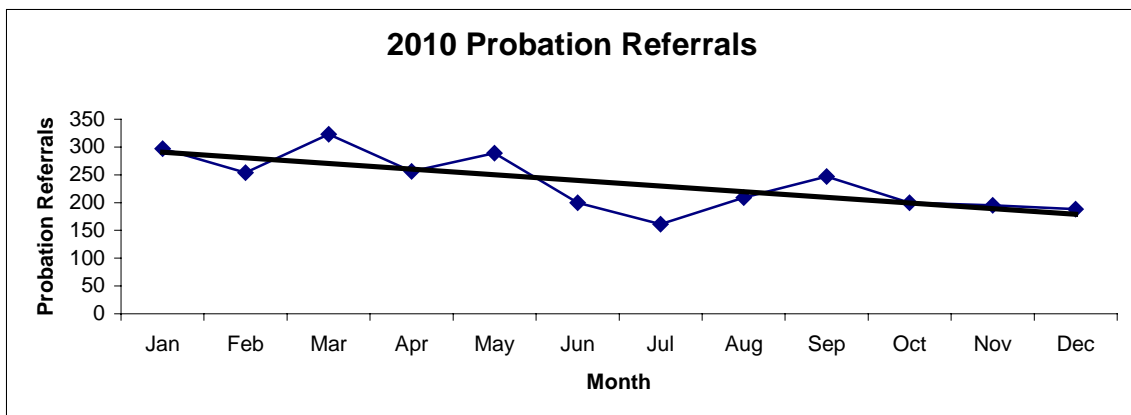
