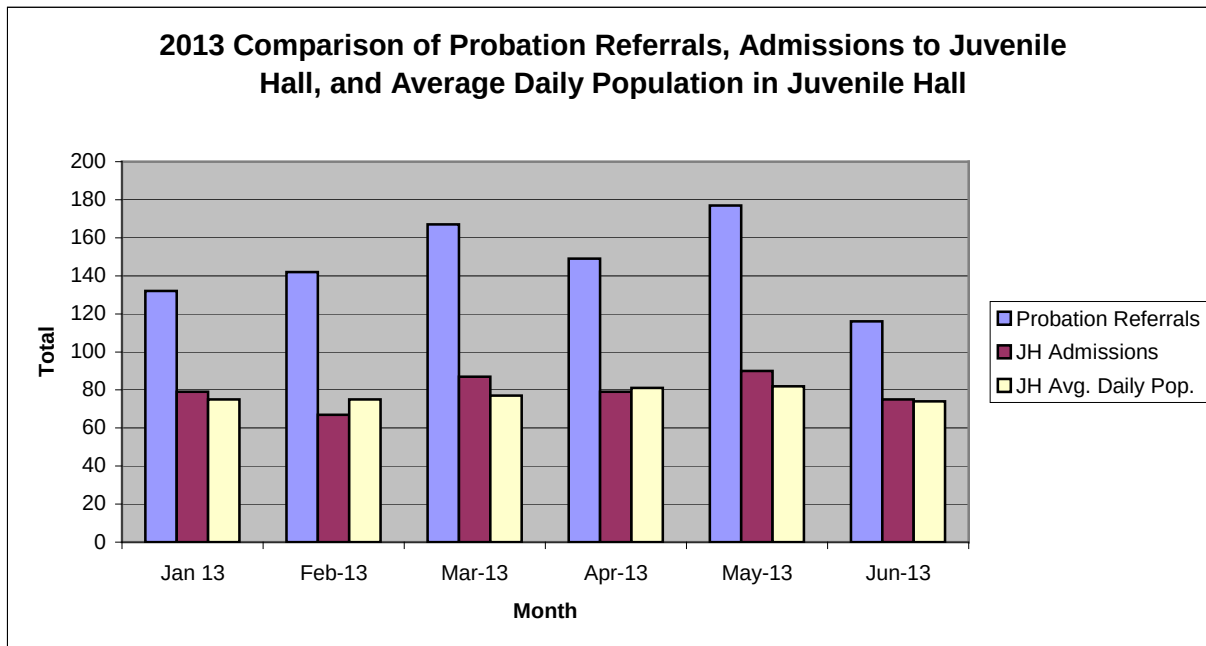

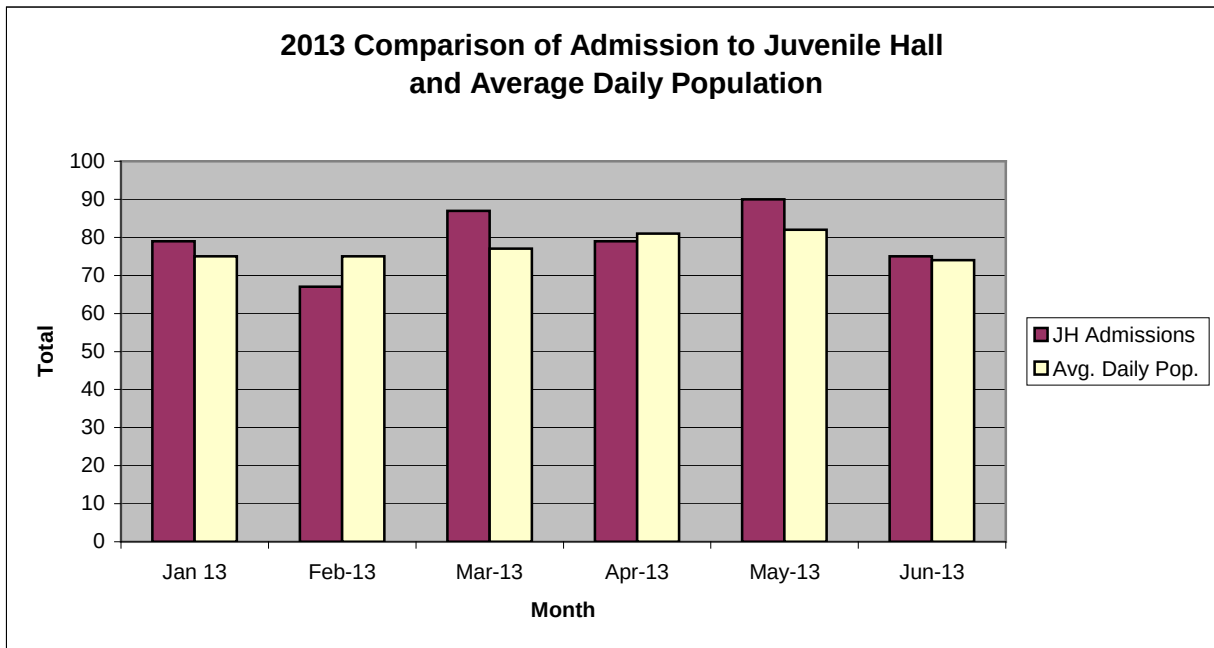

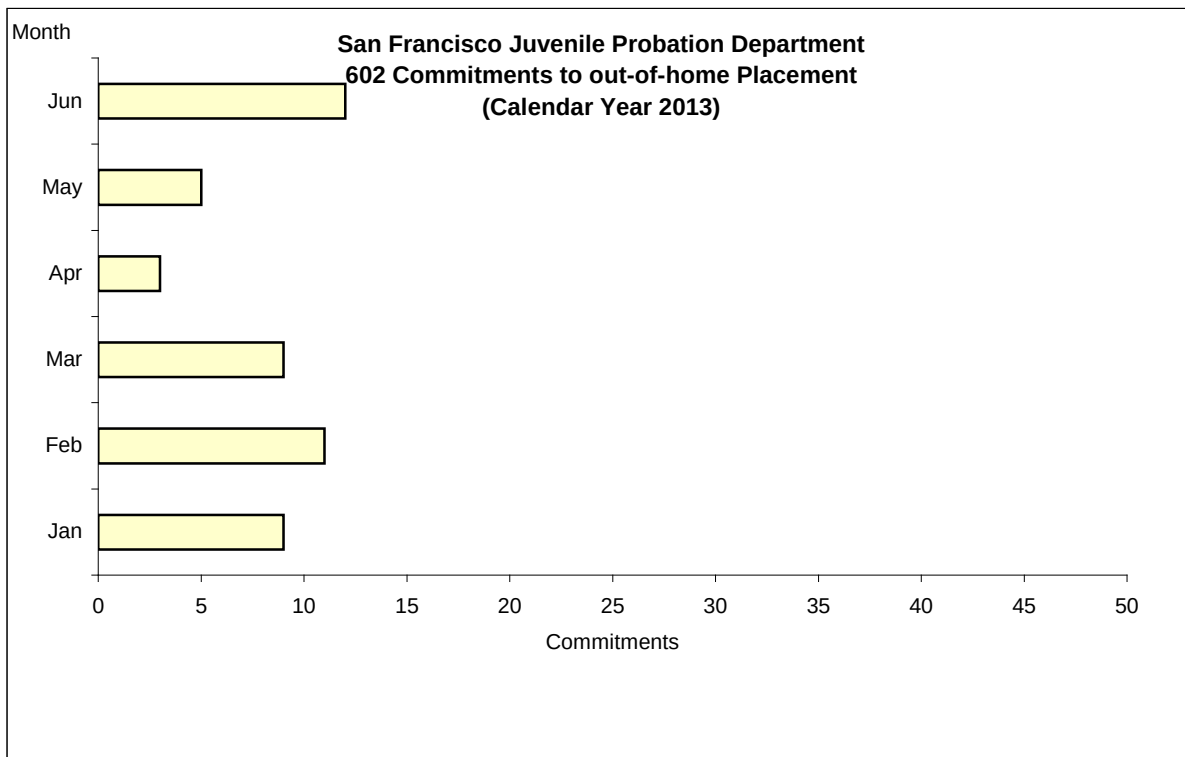


Out-of-Home Placement¹

Of Juvenile Hall Detainees on 6/30/13 by Gender**

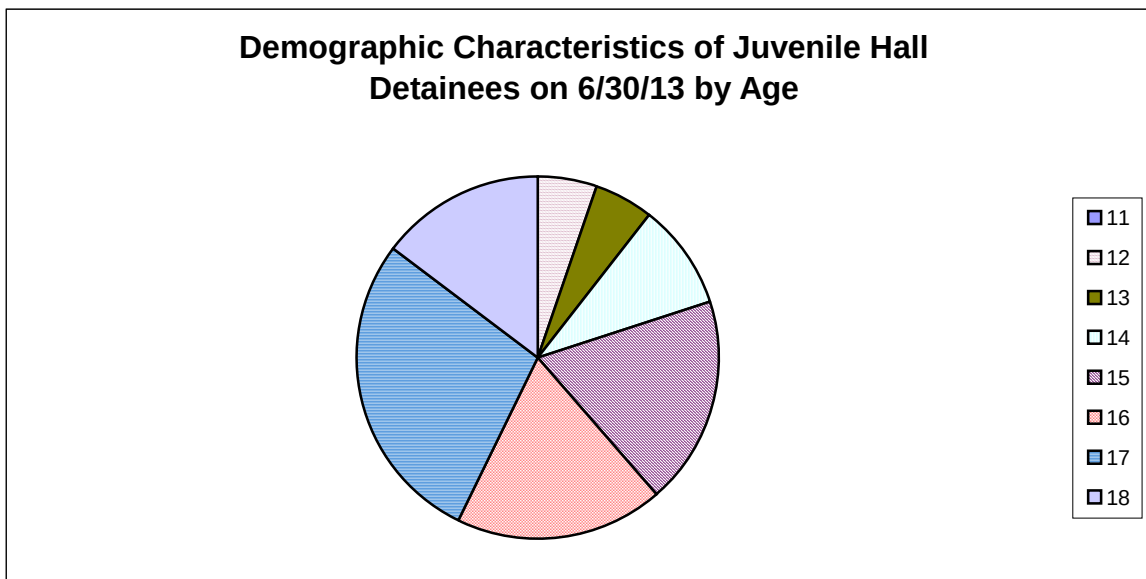

6/30/13 by Race**

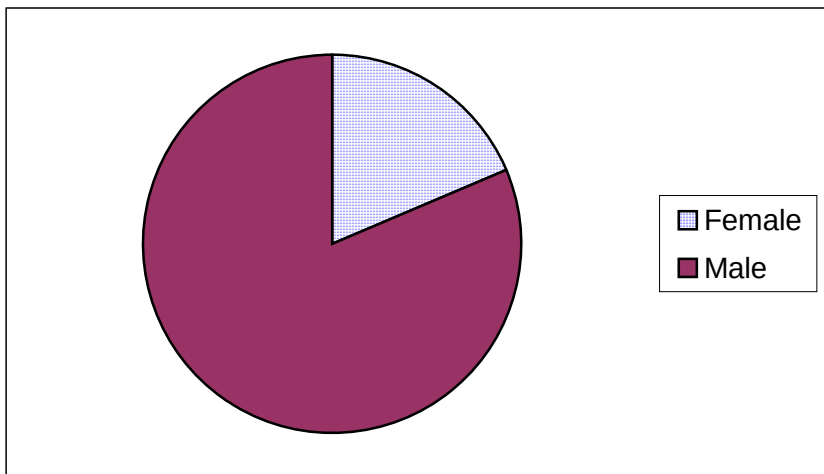

(2008-2010)

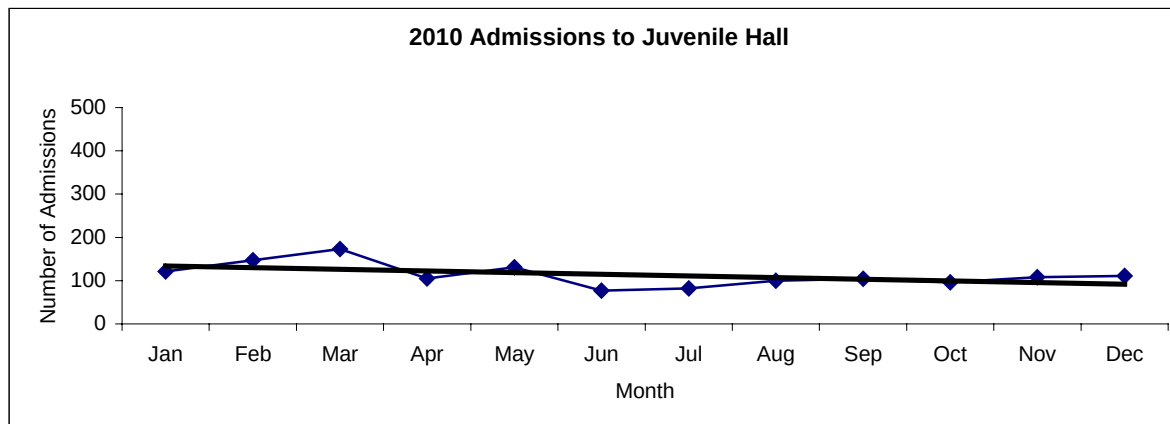

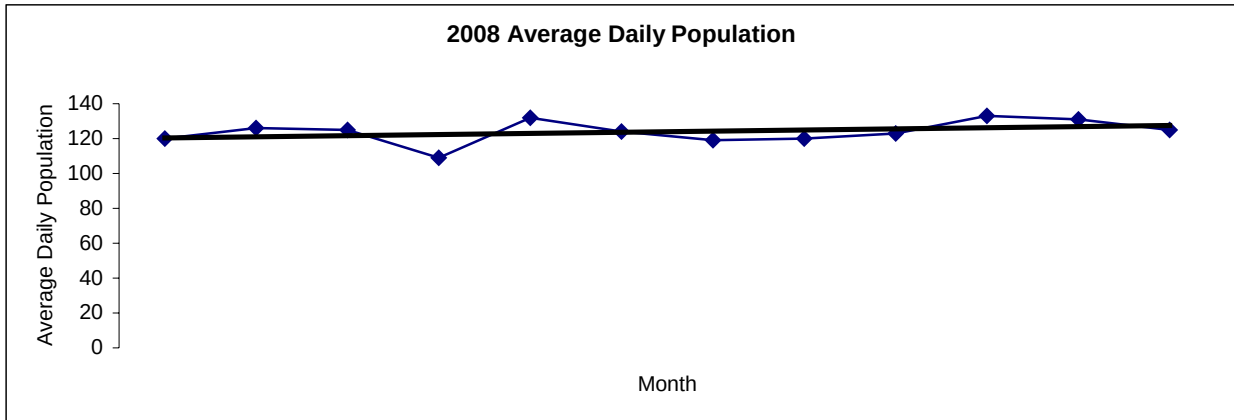

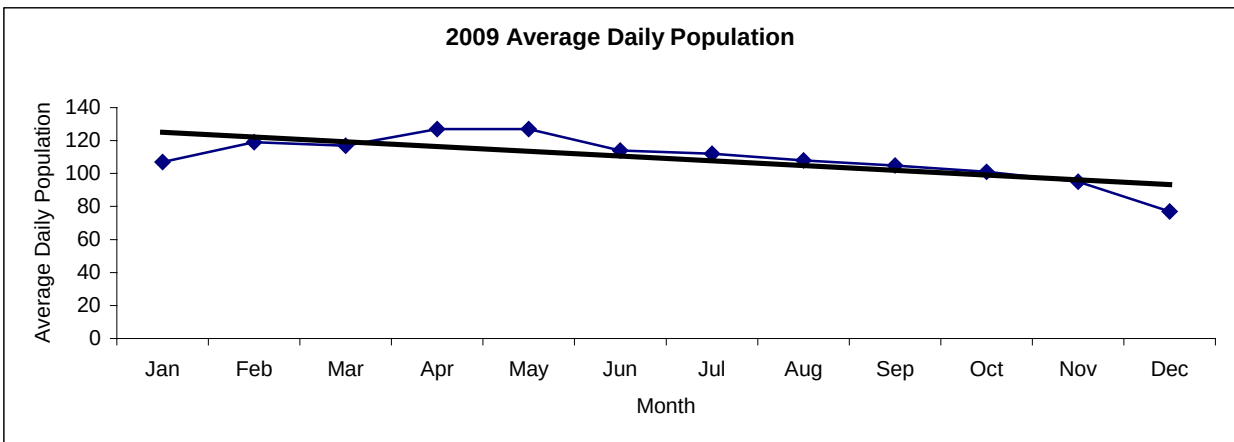

 (2008-2010)

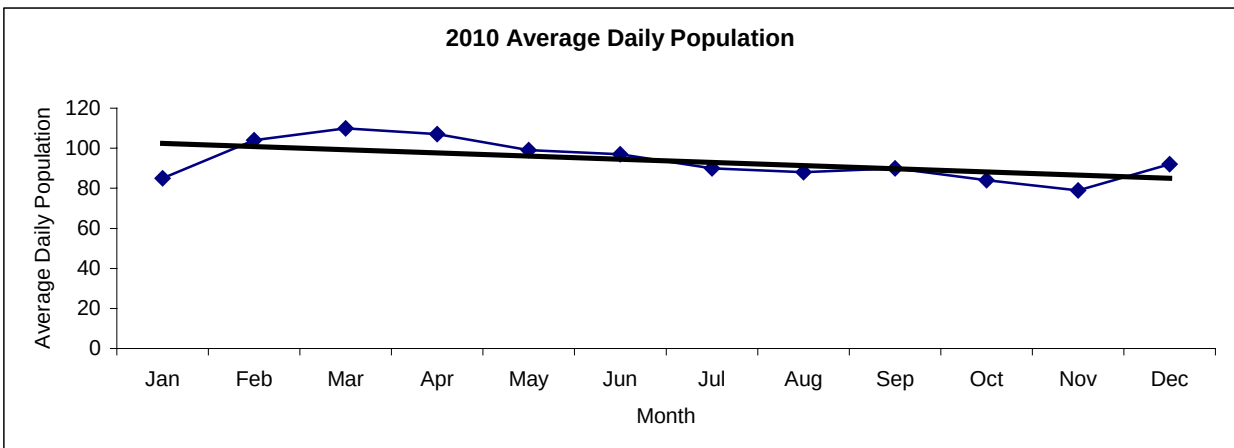
