Status of Community-Based Beds for JPD Youth; Potential Expansion of Beds for Transitional Age Young Adults (AB-12 youth) in JPD system; and Future Agenda Items (DISCUSSION ONLY) Chair Brodkin asked Chief Miller to provide an update on community-based beds for youths in Juvenile Hall and family resource homes. Chief Miller said DCYF is creating an RFP grant. She said JPD will draft RFP and identify grant funding sources. Chief Miller said Catholic Charities is no longer serving girls and she reached out to Edgewood to see if they could be a resource.
 - Chair Brodkin, JPD staff and CBO's discussed the need for housing beds for transitional young adults in Juvenile Hall and funding. Chair Brodkin said the next steps would be designing what is needed, funding and planning a dedicated space.
 - Chair Brodkin said the next meeting will discuss Log Cabin Ranch (LCR).
