BACKGROUND: Log Cabin Ranch (LCR), which opened in the 1950's, closed in 2018 after a series of runaways and the population reached an average of 11 youths. The property has since been vacant. The City owns the property and many people have expressed ideas over the years about how to best use this 614-acres resource in the wooded hills of La Honda.

NOTE: This is an opportunity to hear from the public. No decisions will be made at the meeting – it is part of a conversation. Other meetings are also occurring that could impact the future of LCR, specifically the deliberations of the SB823 Subcommittee of the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council to develop an alternative to DJJ for San Francisco.
