SUBJECT: Item 9: Report to Authorize the Executive Officer to hire a Community

Development Assistant [9770] for CCA Monitoring, Coordination, and

Outreach. (Discussion and Possible Action Item)

The Senior Community Development Specialist [9775] position has been filled and the Commission desired to wait and fill the second position for a Community Development Assistant at the appropriate time. This second position would be needed to make sure LAFCo obligations are meet to ensure a successful launch of the CCA program.

During the course of receiving the authorization from the Department of Human Resources for the Senior Community Development position we requested and received authorization for one position in class 9770 Community Development Assistant to fulfill the second position for LAFCo when the Commission chose to take this action.

This position would report to the Senior Community Development Specialist. The position will administer the office of the LAFCo Commission; administer public information, education and outreach programs to the general public for monitoring of the CCA activities. This position may supervise the design and production of publicity for LAFCo activities, and may work in conjunction or coordinate information and material with the Clean Power SF program of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission.

Staff recommends that the Commission direct the Executive Officer to move forward with hiring the second CCA staff position. The Executive Officer will work with the SFPUC to ensure that any new CCA staff will complement the staff hired by the SFPUC, and will not duplicate the work being performed at the SFPUC.

7	WHEREAS, under Ordinance 0146-07, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors has	
8	directed the Local Agency Formation Commission of the City and County of San Francisco	
9	(LAFCO) to assist with the startup of the Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) Program and	
10	to advise the Board of Supervisors, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SF PUC),	
11	and other agencies regarding all aspects of development, implementation, operation, and	
12	management of the CCA Program; and	
13	WHEREAS, by adopting Resolution No. 2007-01 on September 28, 2007, LAFCO	
14	accepted responsibility to provide monitoring and advice to the Board of Supervisors, SFPUC	
15	and other agencies regarding the CCA Program; and	
16	WHEREAS, the SFPUC has agreed to provide LAFCO with up to \$2.1 million in funds	
17	between 2007 and 2010 for its role in the CCA Program; and	
18	WHEREAS, at its hearings held on September 12, 2008, and November 21, 2008, the	
19	Commission heard presentations on two proposed positions for LAFCO staff members to	
20	assist with the development and implementation of the CCA Program, including an	
21	Administrative Assistant/Community Liaison and a Senior Program Officer; and	
22	WHEREAS, at its March 16, 2009 hearing, the Government Audit and Oversight	
23	Committee for the City and County of San Francisco approved the proposal to add two	
24	LAFCO staff members to assist with the development and implementation of the CCA	
25	program; and	

1	WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 50-09, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors,	
2	the Board of Supervisors, authorized the Interim Executive Officer, with the assistance and	
3	cooperation of the SFPUC, to fill these positions as needed; and	
4	WHEREAS, the Interim Executive Officer would only fill these positions should it be	
5	determined, in cooperation with the SFPUC, that these positions would complement any staff	
6	recently hired by the SFPUC and would not duplicate the work being performed by that	
7	agency; and	
8	WHEREAS, on August 10, 2009 the Senior Community Development position was	
9	filled as a limited term position and the public outreach on this program will be starting with th	
10	release of the RFP for the program; now, therefore, be it	
11	RESOLVED, that the Local Agency Formation Commission of the City and County of	
12	San Francisco authorizes the Interim Executive Officer, with the assistance and cooperation	
13	of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, to hire a Community Development Assistan	
14	consistent with the Policies and Procedures of the City and County of San Francisco. The	
15	position will be a limited term position not to exceed three (3) years.
