Consideration and Approval of Amended LAFCo Budget 2007-2008 and Request

for Executive Officer to Release an RFQ for Project Consultant(s).

This item is continued from last meeting. The Board of Supervisors passed Ordinance 0146-07 requesting that LAFCO provide an advisory and monitoring role in the implementation of the Community Choice Aggregation ("CCA") program.

At the September 28, 2007 meeting LAFCO adopted Resolution 2007-01 accepting the advisory role and the funds earmarked for it. This item allows for the amendment of the LAFCo budget for the Fiscal Year 2007-2008 to include the estimated funds available for use in the CCA Advisory program. An Operating Budget is also attached. LAFCo will provide the advisory service only after prior approval of the expenditures by the LAFCo.

A Draft Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") for a Consultant(s) to Provide Advisory Services is all attached. The RFQ follows the format used by LAFCo in preparing its last four studies for LAFCo dealing with electric issues, CCA implementation and municipalization. The RFQ seeks a qualified Consulting team to provide advisory services regarding the CCA Implementation Program as requested. The RFQ utilizes City and County of San Francisco competitive bidding and contracting procedures acknowledging that LAFCo is a separate legal entity. A panel would conduct the review and/or interview process. LAFCo will select the consultant(s).

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7	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco has
8	instituted a city-wide renewable energy plan under the State of California's Community
9	Choice Aggregation law (AB 117, Migden- 2002) by adopting Ordinances 86-04; 146-07 and
10	147-07 which are incorporated by this reference as though set forth at length; and
11	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) has
12	been specifically requested in ordinance 147-07 to undertake a role to provide advice and to
13	monitor the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's (SFPUC) implementation of the
14	City's renewable energy plan; and,
15	WHEREAS, LAFCo has been substantively involved in developing the CCA Program
16	and has subsequently accepted the responsibility to provide monitoring of and advice to the
17	Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco and SFPUC regarding
18	implementation of the City's renewable energy plan through Community Choice Aggregation
19	(hereafter referred to as the "CCA Program") as contemplated by the ordinances incorporated
20	herein and as formally accepted in its Resolution number 2007-01 adopted September 28,
21	2007, which is incorporated by this reference as though set forth at length; and,
22	WHEREAS, LAFCo, having formally accepted responsibility to undertake said role will
23	establish a CCA Program Advice and Monitoring Project (The Project) pursuant to the request
24	of the Board of Supervisors; and,

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1	WHEREAS, LAFCo understands that the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission
2	has agreed to provide LAFCo with funds up to \$2.1 million over a three (3) year period for the
3	purposes of conducting The Project; and,
4	WHEREAS, LAFCo is authorized under California Government Code §56380
5	(Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000) to make its own
6	provision for necessary, quarters, equipment, supplies and personnel by contract with any
7	public agency or private party; and,
8	WHEREAS, LAFCo, in order to fulfill its duties as requested, will require retention of a
9	consultant(s) knowledgeable in the law and regulations pertaining to Community Choice
10	Aggregation ; Now Therefore, be it
