## 1 [Ed Harrington Commendation of Distinguished Service] 2 3 **Resolution commending the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission General** 4 Manager, Ed Harrington, for his years of distinguished service to the City and County 5 of San Francisco. 6 7 WHEREAS, After serving the City and its citizens with honor and distinction as 8 Controller for 17 years, Ed Harrington was nominated by the San Francisco Public Utilities 9 Commission (SFPUC), and appointed by Mayor Gavin Newsom, to serve as General 10 Manager of the SFPUC in March, 2008; and 11 WHEREAS, During his tenure as SFPUC General Manager, Ed Harrington used his 12 exceptional financial management, extensive knowledge of City operations, outstanding 13 leadership, and commitment to community improvement to guide the SFPUC through a period 14 of unprecedented success across the water, wastewater and power enterprises; and 15 WHEREAS, Ed Harrington directed the SFPUC's pursue an innovative program of 16 energy efficiency and conservation, including the installation of substantial new renewable 17 energy sources in San Francisco. His tenure at the helm of the SFPUC has seen him guide 18 the agency to the forefront of creating policy aimed at the development of renewable 19 resources and creative strategies to combat the growing problems in our energy sector; and 20 WHEREAS, Through Mr. Harrington's deep commitment to improving the lives of 21 disadvantaged San Francisco residents, he led the SFPUC to become the first utility in the 22 nation to establish a Community Benefits Policy and Environmental Justice Policy, which has 23 guided the agency to ensure that water, wastewater, and power operations meaningfully 24 benefit low-income people and minorities in San Francisco and regionally; and 25

WHEREAS, Mr. Harrington's work with the City's Local Hire Ordinance has resulted in
unprecedented numbers of local business enterprises certified for SFPUC which was due in
large part to the support and resources marshaled across political lines and different agencies
by Mr. Harrington; and
WHEREAS, Ed Harrington was instrumental in the development the Community
Choice Aggregation which was approved by the Board of Supervisors. Without his

leadership, foresight, diligence, and drive the program would likely had floundered rather than
becoming a model for clean power that cities and counties across the country will emulate;
