3 **Resolution commending the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission General**
4 **Manager, Ed Harrington, for his years of distinguished service to the City and County**
5 **of San Francisco.**

7 WHEREAS, After serving the City and its citizens with honor and distinction as
8 Controller for 17 years, Ed Harrington was nominated by the San Francisco Public Utilities
9 Commission (SFPUC), and appointed by Mayor Gavin Newsom, to serve as General
10 Manager of the SFPUC in March, 2008; and

11 WHEREAS, During his tenure as SFPUC General Manager, Ed Harrington used his
12 exceptional financial management, extensive knowledge of City operations, outstanding
13 leadership, and commitment to community improvement to guide the SFPUC through a period
14 of unprecedented success across the water, wastewater and power enterprises; and

15 WHEREAS, Ed Harrington directed the SFPUC's pursue an innovative program of
16 energy efficiency and conservation, including the installation of substantial new renewable
17 energy sources in San Francisco. His tenure at the helm of the SFPUC has seen him guide
18 the agency to the forefront of creating policy aimed at the development of renewable
19 resources and creative strategies to combat the growing problems in our energy sector; and

20 WHEREAS, Through Mr. Harrington's deep commitment to improving the lives of
21 disadvantaged San Francisco residents, he led the SFPUC to become the first utility in the
22 nation to establish a Community Benefits Policy and Environmental Justice Policy, which has
23 guided the agency to ensure that water, wastewater, and power operations meaningfully
24 benefit low-income people and minorities in San Francisco and regionally; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Harrington’s work with the City’s Local Hire Ordinance has resulted in
2 unprecedented numbers of local business enterprises certified for SFPUC which was due in
3 large part to the support and resources marshaled across political lines and different agencies
4 by Mr. Harrington; and

5 WHEREAS, Ed Harrington was instrumental in the development the Community
6 Choice Aggregation which was approved by the Board of Supervisors. Without his
7 leadership, foresight, diligence, and drive the program would likely had floundered rather than
8 becoming a model for clean power that cities and counties across the country will emulate;
9 now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Local Agency Formation hereby congratulates Ed
11 Harrington on an outstanding career of service to the people of San Francisco and expresses
12 its deepest gratitude for his dedicated, knowledgeable, and forward-thinking leadership
13 serving the City and County of San Francisco and its citizens. While the SFPUC and San
14 Francisco will surely miss the abilities and leadership of a man like Ed Harrington, we wish
15 him the best in his well-deserved retirement and starting a new chapter in his life. This is not
16 goodbye, but a celebration and thanks to the career of a true public servant.

4 **Choice Aggregation Director, Mike Campbell, for four years of distinguished service to**

7 WHEREAS, Mike Campbell worked at the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission
8 (SFPUC) from 2008 to 2012 in the Power Enterprise Department as the Community Choice
9 Aggregation (CCA) Director; and

10 WHEREAS, During his tenure at the SFPUC, Mike Campbell used his experience in
11 the energy generation field to guide the CCA program through to the creation of the
12 CleanPowerSF program; and

13 WHEREAS, Mike Campbell helped craft multiple requests for proposals to ensure that
14 the CleanPowerSF program had both technical assistance and a service provider in order to
15 launch; and

16 WHEREAS, Mike Campbell led the negotiation team to acquire contracts for energy
17 supply as well as back office services critical to launching CleanPowerSF; and

18 WHEREAS, Mike Campbell led countless meeting between the SFPUC, the Local
19 Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo), and community advocates to ensure that the
20 program drafted for implementation met both the City's and advocates' needs and goals; and

21 WHEREAS, Mike Campbell's monthly updates to LAFCo allowed the commissioners to
22 stay apprised of the latest developments and give feedback on necessary changes to
23 successfully launch CleanPowerSF; and

24 WHEREAS, Mike Campbell's deep commitment to CleanPowerSF ensured a viable
25 program that met all the requirements the City set forth; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission hereby
