4. Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) Activities Report

A. <u>Status Update on CleanPowerSF Program</u>

Barbara Hale, Assistant General Manager, Power - SF Public Utilities Commission (SF PUC), discussed PUC's financial situation with the Commission and the various reasons for its current state. A joint meeting between LAFCo and SF PUC will be scheduled to discuss proposals on how to move forward and the budget situation.

Nancy Miller, Interim Executive Officer, and Jason Fried, Senior Program Officer, LAFCo, presented information and answered questions raised throughout the discussion.

B. Status Update on Proceedings at the California Public Utilities Commission

Barbara Hale, Assistant General Manager, Power - SF PUC, discussed PG&E's green tariff program and how the cost is being subsidized, along with other proceedings currently happening at the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC).

C. <u>Request for Proposals (RFP) to Provide Build Out Strategy and Plan for CleanPowerSF</u> <u>Program (Energy Efficiency, Facilities, and Local Jobs Policy)</u>

Nancy Miller, Interim Executive Officer, LAFCo, reviewed the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the build out of the program, the specifics of its content, and what the Commission would like to see added or taken out.

D. <u>Approval of an Extension to the Memorandum of Understanding with the San Francisco</u> <u>Public Utilities Commission (SF PUC), dated April 17, 2009</u>
