# Enrollment and Service Statistics

- Enrolled >409,000 customer accounts
- 4.59% opt-out rate (95+% retention) since launch
- 2.14% SuperGreen 100% renewable upgrade rate
- SuperGreen now accounts for >16% of retail sales

# 2022 Renewable Energy Supplies Request for Offers

(PRO.0263)

- Sought bids for new or existing renewable energy resources for CleanPowerSF customers
- Preference for resources located within the 9-County Bay Area
- Preference for resources that were eligible under the California PUC's Mid-Term Reliability Procurement Order
- Start energy deliveries as early as January 2023 and as late as December 2028
- Contract terms up to 25 years

# IP Easley Solar Project

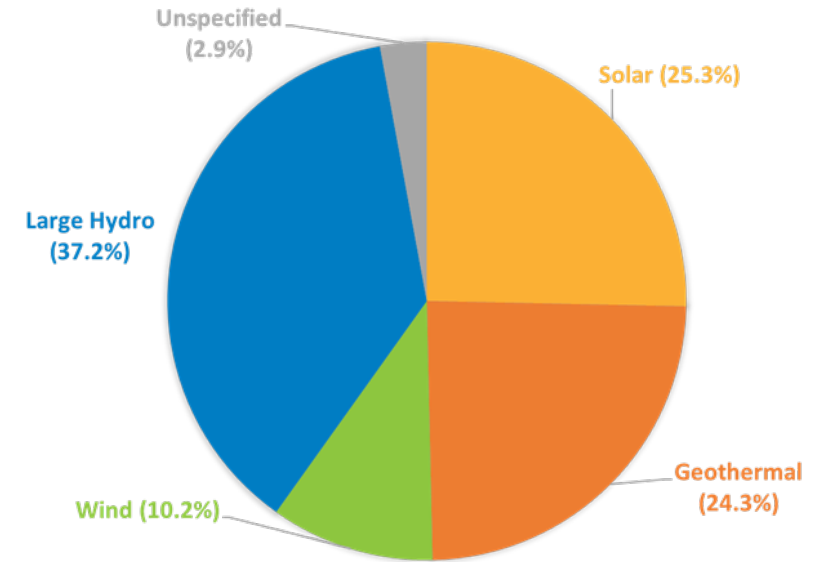
- Developer: Intersect Power
- Product: Portfolio Content Category (PCC1) renewable energy
- Project size: 50 MW share of 400 MW facility
- Location: Riverside County
- Technology: Solar Photovoltaic
- Labor: 5-trade Project Labor Agreement
- Commercial Operation Date: September 2026 (expected)
- Contract term: 10 years



# CleanPowerSF Portfolio

- CleanPowerSF's power portfolio is clean – in 2022 the
  - Default Green product was 97% renewable
  - SuperGreen product was 100% CA Renewable Portfolio Standard-eligible
- Mix of solar, wind, geothermal, hydroelectric
- IP Easley will add solar generation to the portfolio

# Back Office Services Contract Extension, CS-247(R)



- Contract CS-247(R) provides essential billing and data management services and is set to expire in October 2024.
- SFPUC is seeking a 6-month extension of the existing agreement (through April 2025).
- Extension will ensure continuity of operations while staff complete competitive solicitation to replace the existing agreement.
