Lack of data about the size of SF's contractor labor force

No data to determine if companies' labor models ensure fairness

City lacks regulatory authority over TNCs (transportation network companies)



# Purpose of Labor Study

Determine if companies' labor models align with the City's labor principle

Conduct a representative survey of on-demand workers in this sector

Identify best practice labor models in major U.S. cities and internationally


