

Free and Low-Cost Health Care Services in San Francisco

Individuals without health coverage are able to access free or low-cost health care services at more than 25 clinic sites across the City. Services vary by clinic site, and may include medical, dental, and vision care. Individuals with incomes below 500% of the federal poverty level (approximately \$73,000 for a family of 3) are eligible for services on a sliding fee scale or for free care. Health Insurance Coverage for Your Family

If your child is uninsured, there are health insurance programs for children. It is very likely that your child will be eligible for one of the following programs. These programs offer coverage at a very small monthly charge and in some cases, at no charge.

Healthy Families or Medi-Cal for Children

Healthy Families and Medi-Cal for Children offers medical, dental, and vision coverage for low-income children up to age 19 in California. Healthy Kids

Healthy Kids offers medical, dental, and vision coverage for children up to age 19 regardless of the immigration status of the child or parents. There is a monthly premium of \$4 per child. For more information, contact the San Francisco Health Plan at (415) 777-9992.

Kaiser Cares for Kids

Kaiser Permanente offers medical and vision coverage for children up to age 19 who are ineligible for Medi-Cal or Healthy Families, regardless of immigration status. For more information, contact Kaiser Permanente at 1-800-255-5053.
