Article 33H of the Police Code is hereby amended by revising Section 3300H.4, to read as follows: SEC. 3300H.4. SUPPLEMENTAL PAID PARENTAL LEAVE, Existing Paid Parental Leave Policies. This Article 33H does not require a (d)Covered Employer to provide Supplemental Compensation under Section 3300H.4 to a Covered Employee if the employer's existing policy provides the employee with at least six weeks fully paid parental leave for at least the number of weeks paid leave is required by the California Paid Family Leave law, as amended from time to time, within any twelve-month period for purposes of New Child Bonding, whether or not such paid leave includes California Paid Family Leave benefits. Unless the Employee elects otherwise, the six weeks fully paid parental leave referenced in the prior sentence must be provided as six consecutive weeks.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
