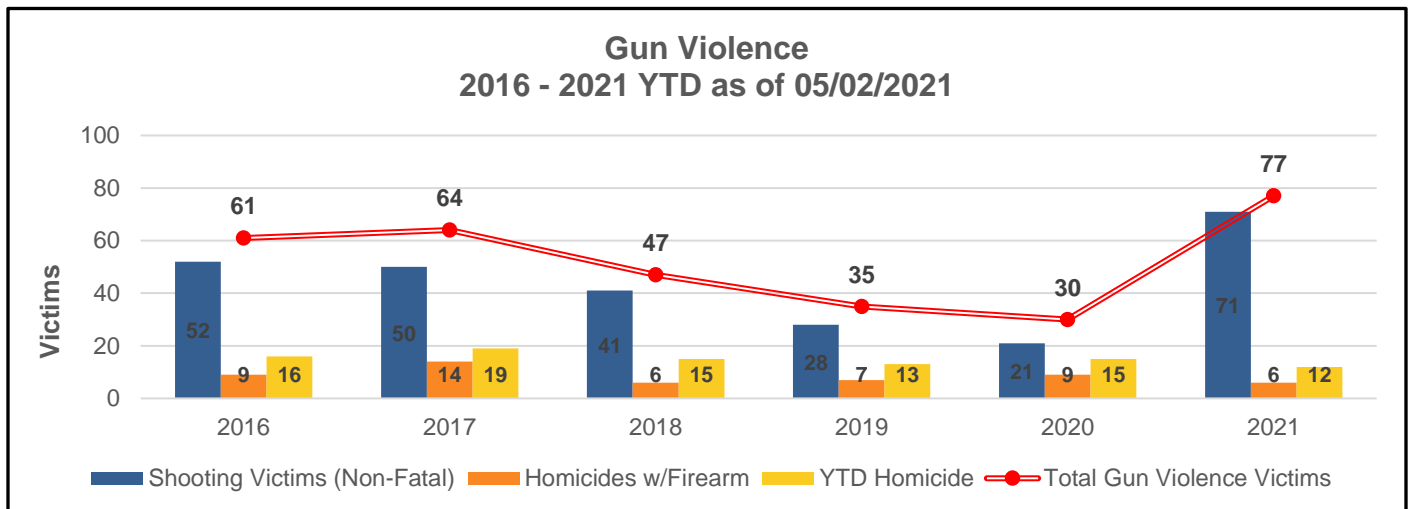

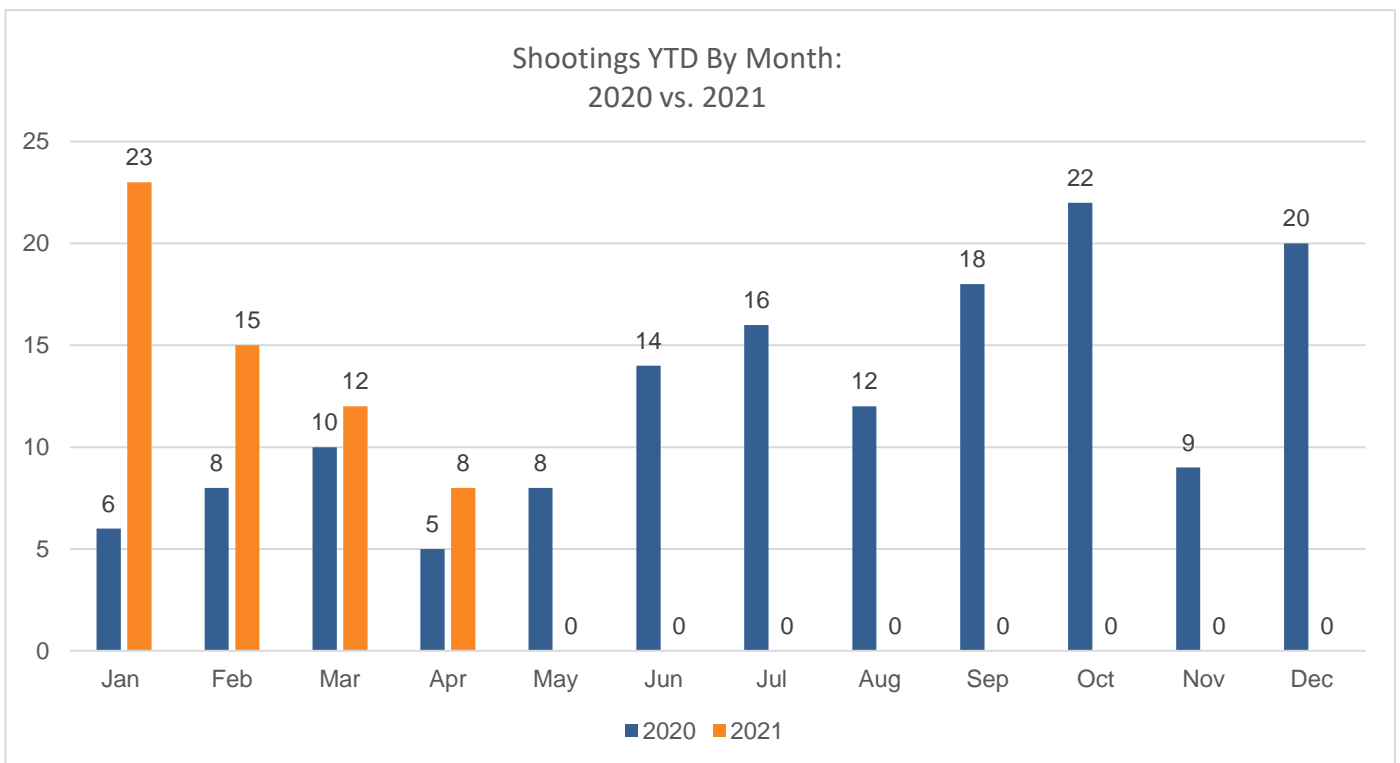
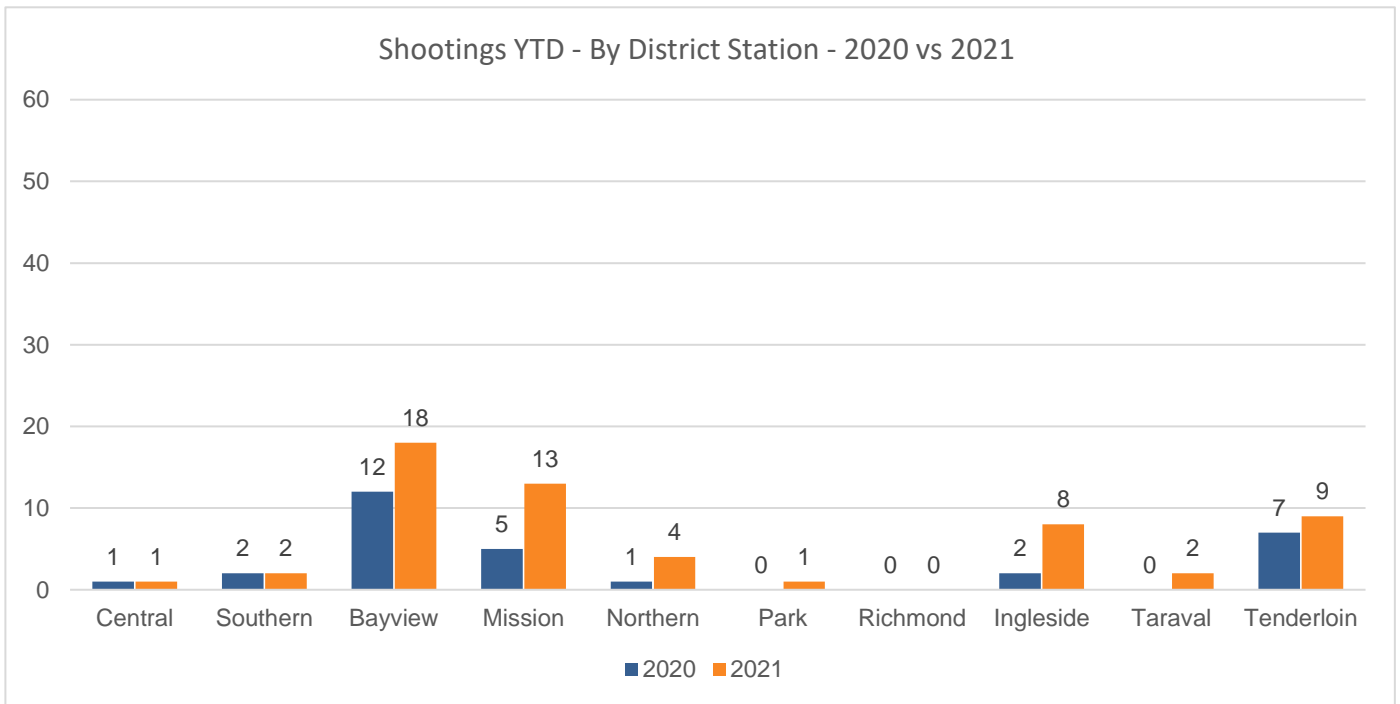

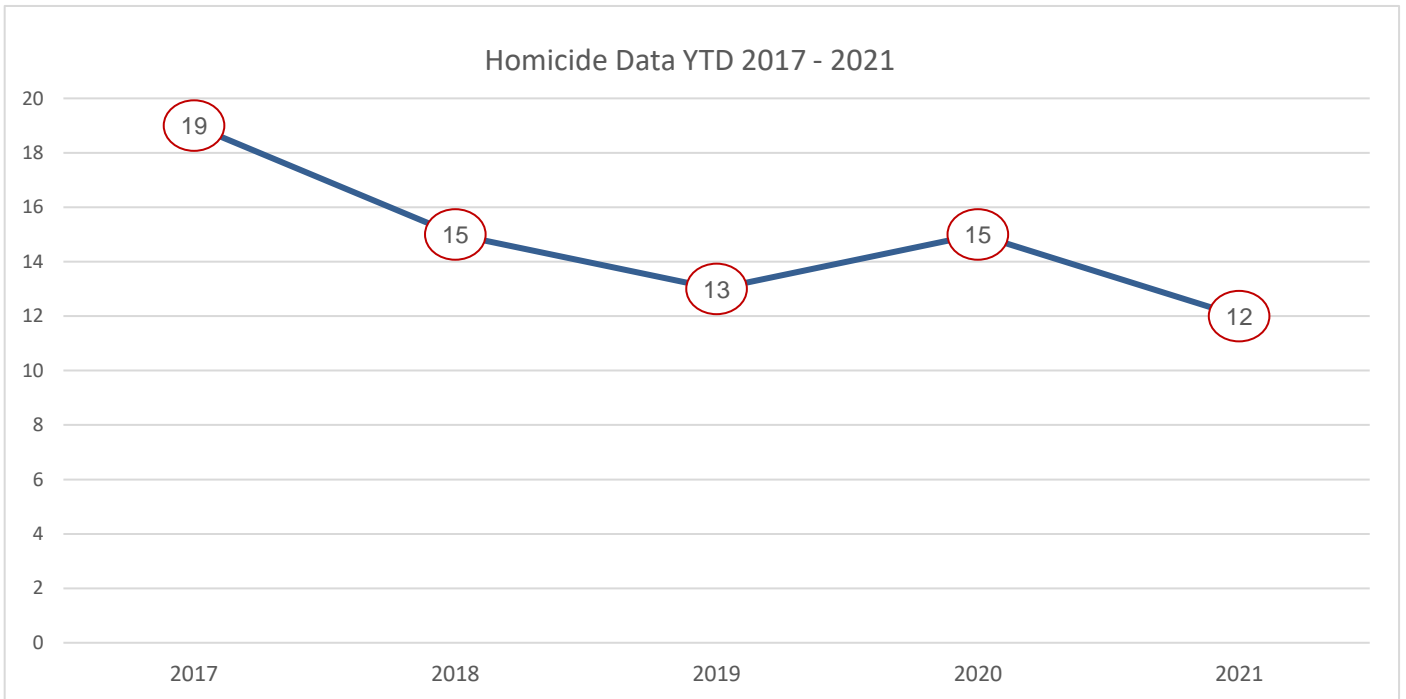
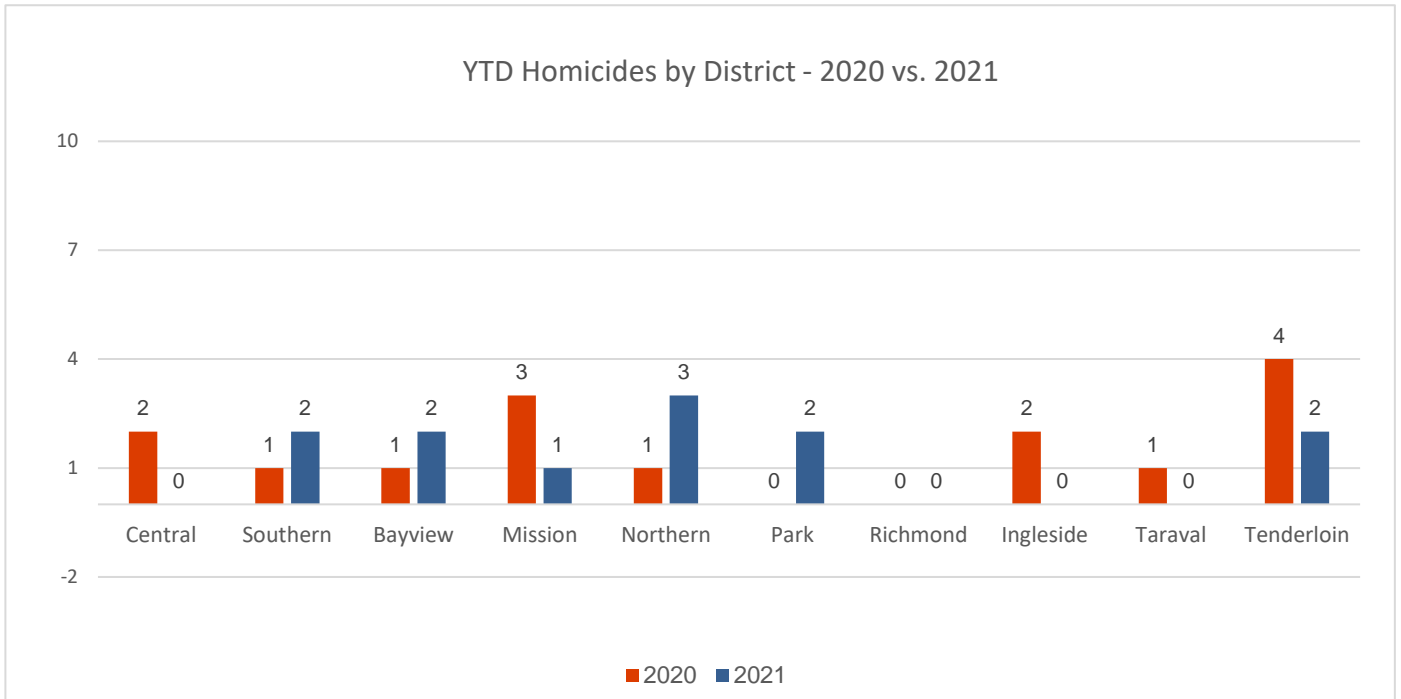
GUN VIOLENCE – Is UP 157% compared to 2020

- **There was one (1) shooting incident causing injuries to one (1) individual the week ending 05/02/2021**
 *Note - an additional two victims received gunshot injuries as a result of a homicide incident.
 - There are a total of **58 incidents** resulting in **77 victims** YTD.
- **There was one (1) homicide the week ending 05/02/2021**
 - There are **12 homicides** YTD
 - There is **3 homicide** in April
 - There were **2 homicides** in March
 - **6** of the **12** cases are cleared; **5** cleared by arrest, **1** cleared by exceptional = 50% Clearance YTD
