During the period that officer lacks a valid driver's license, officer shall not drive in the course of duties. Therefore assignments shall be at the sole discretion of the Chief of Police until officer's license to drive is restored; Officer shall continue to participate in the DGO 11.11 Program during the abeyance period; shall not consume alcohol or non-prescribed medications or illegal drugs during that time, whether on duty or off duty; Officer shall be subject to random and regular alcohol testing by the Department during his participation in the DGO 11.11 Program. Testing shall occur no less than monthly. Should any blood alcohol test reveal any measurable amount of alcohol in officer's system, the Commission may deem that test a positive result in violation of the officer's DGO 11.11 treatment plan. The Chief of Police retain sole discretion over the form and frequency of any other treatment under the DGO 11.11 Program and may designate a member of the Department to exercise that discretion on his behalf.
