Department General Order 3.10 - Firearm Discharge Review Board

This order outlines the functions and responsibilities of the Firearm Discharge Review Board and delineates the procedures for reviewing, investigating, and reporting to the Police Commission, cases in which members discharge a firearm.

DUTIES OF THE BOARD

It is the policy of the San Francisco Police Department to review every instance in which a firearm is discharged whether or not such discharge results in an injury or death. The Firearm Discharge Review Board shall review every discharge of a firearm by a member. The purpose of this review process is to ensure that the department is continually reviewing its training, policy and procedures in light of the circumstances that lead to firearm discharges by members and to determine if the discharge was in policy.

COMPOSITION OF THE FDRB BOARD

The Department Firearm Discharge Review Board shall be composed of:

Member of the Police Commission, Advisory

Deputy Chief of the Administration Bureau, Chair

Deputy Chief of the Field Operations Bureau

Deputy Chief of the Airport Bureau

Deputy Chief of the Investigations Bureau

Commanding Officer Training Division, Advisory

Range Master, Advisory

Field Tactics Force Options, Advisory

Commanding Officer of Risk Management Office, Advisory

Director of the Department of Police Accountability, Advisory

The Police Commission member shall be appointed by the Commission President and serve a one-year term

Department General Order 8.12 – In-Custody Deaths

This order outlines the rules and procedures to be followed in the investigation, review and reporting to the Police Commission of In-Custody Death investigations.

DUTIES OF THE BOARD

The In-Custody Death Review Board shall discuss the circumstances surrounding the in-custody death and the response of the officers(s). The Board shall submit to the Chief of Police a written summary which shall include recommendations concerning adherence to department policy, the need to develop policy, the need to develop new training and techniques, and whether or not the conduct of the involved-officer(s) was proper or improper.

COMPOSITION OF THE IN-CUSTODY REVIEW BOARD

The In-Custody Review Board shall be composed of:

- Member of the Police Commission, Advisory
- Deputy Chief of the Administration Bureau, Chair
- Deputy Chief of the Field Operations Bureau
- Deputy Chief of the Airport Bureau
- Deputy Chief of the Investigations Bureau
- Commanding Officer Training Division, Advisory
- Commanding Officer Risk Management Office, Advisory
- Designated Public Health Physician, Advisory
- Director of the Department of Police Accountability, Advisory
- Medical Examiner, Advisory
