

GUN VIOLENCE – Is UP 286% compared to 2020


There were 2 shooting incidents causing injuries to 2 individuals the week ending 03/08/2021
There are a total of 40 incidents resulting in 54 victims YTD.


• There were no homicides the week ending 03/08/2021


- There are **7 homicides** YTD which is a 75% increase over 2020

 - There were **3 homicides** in January
 - 7 of the 7 cases are cleared; 6 cleared by arrest, 1 cleared by exceptional = 100% Clearance YTD
