Investigative Services Detail

Internal Affairs – Criminal Unit Name Change and Responsibilities

Effective May 4, 2019 the following unit name has been changed.

- Internal Affairs – Criminal (IA-Crim) is now the **Investigative Services Detail (ISD)**.

ISD shall be responsible for the following types of investigations:

- Officer Involved Shootings
- In-custody death
- Use of force resulting in great bodily injury
- Member involved criminal conduct
- Any investigation designated by the Chief of Police

The Investigative Services Detail's new areas of responsibility will affect the following Department General Orders, Department Bulletins and Department Manuals. ISD will be responsible for the duties previously assigned to Homicide or IA-Criminal in the following orders and manuals:

- DGO 3.10: Firearm Discharge Review Board
- DGO 6.20: Member-Involved Domestic Violence
- DGO 8.11: Investigations of Officer Involved Shootings and Discharges
- DGO 8.12: In-Custody Deaths
- DB 19-028: Obtaining a Public Safety Statement
- DB 18-040: Release of Information to the News Media and/or Public regarding Homicide Investigations (regarding OIS/ICD)
- DM16 Section K: In-Custody Deaths
- DM16 Section P: Officer-Involved Shootings
- FOB GO 04-03: Officer-Involved Shootings
