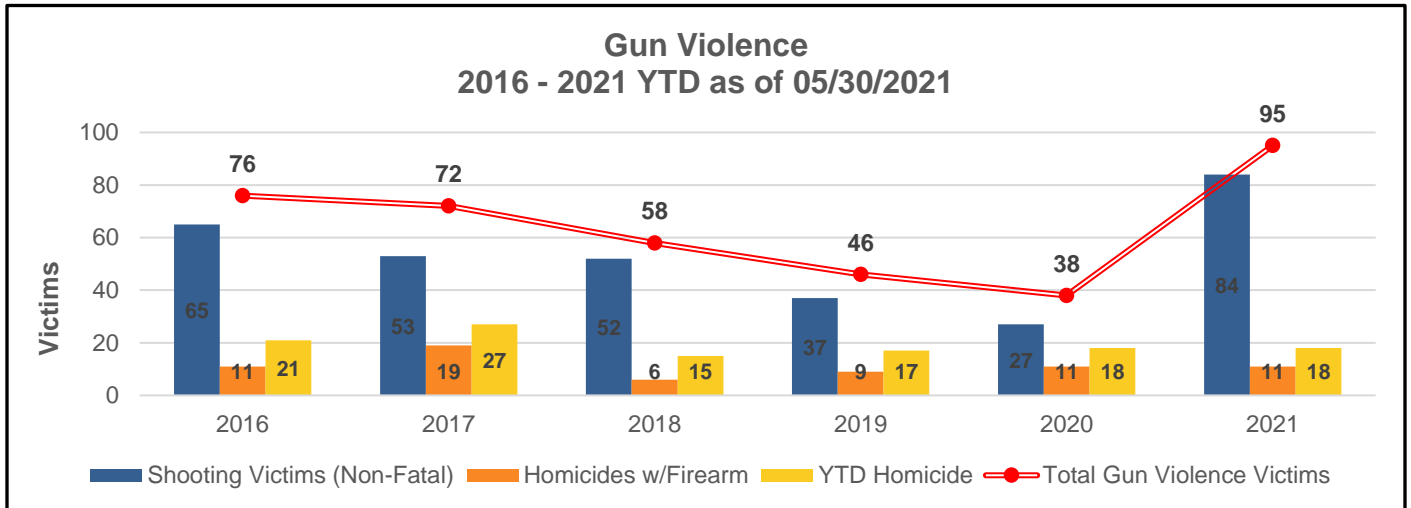

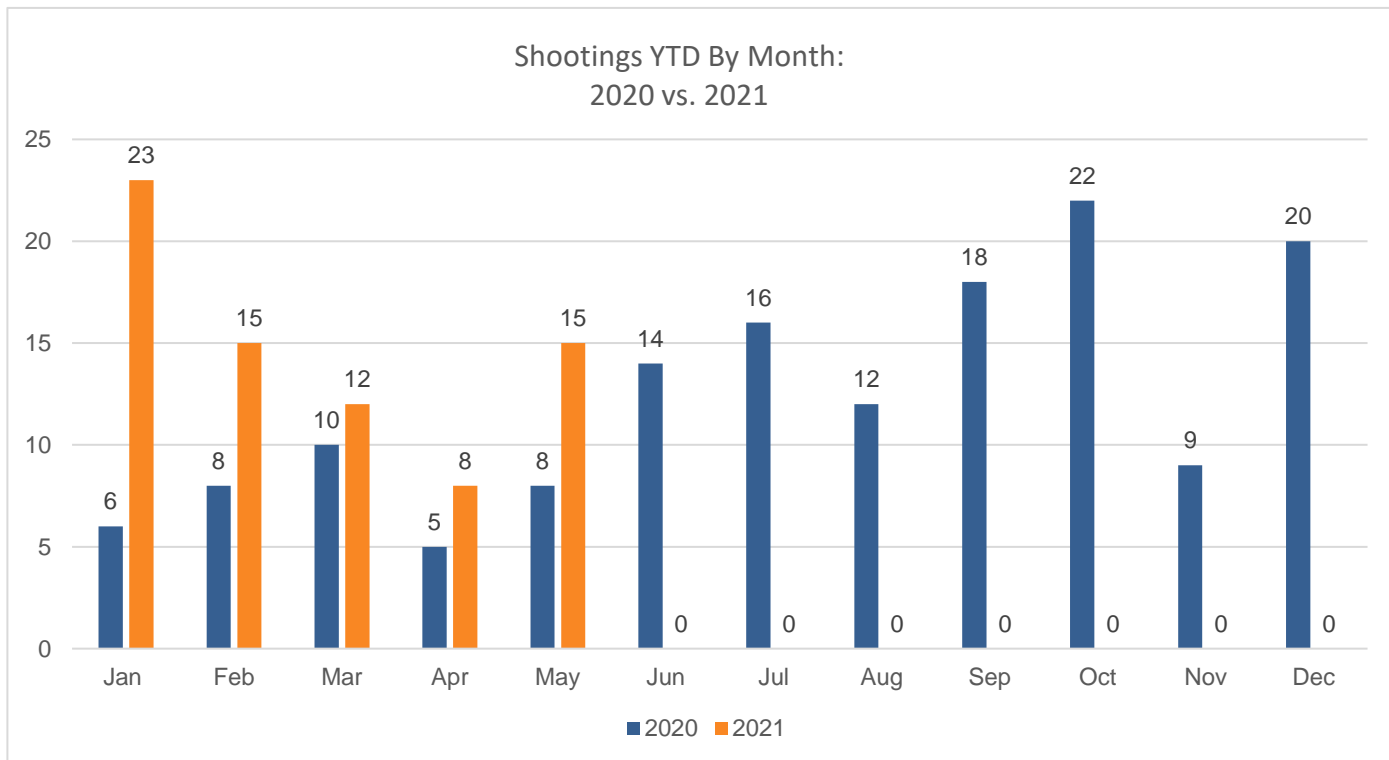

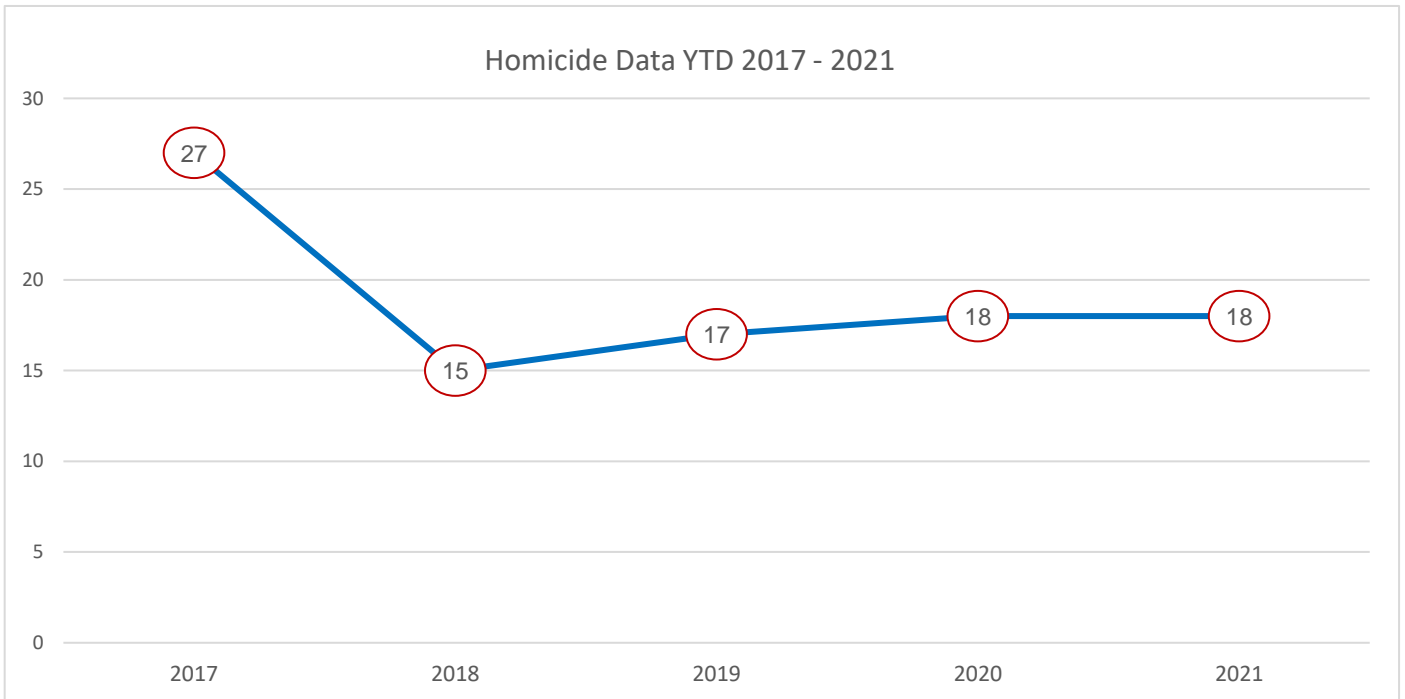
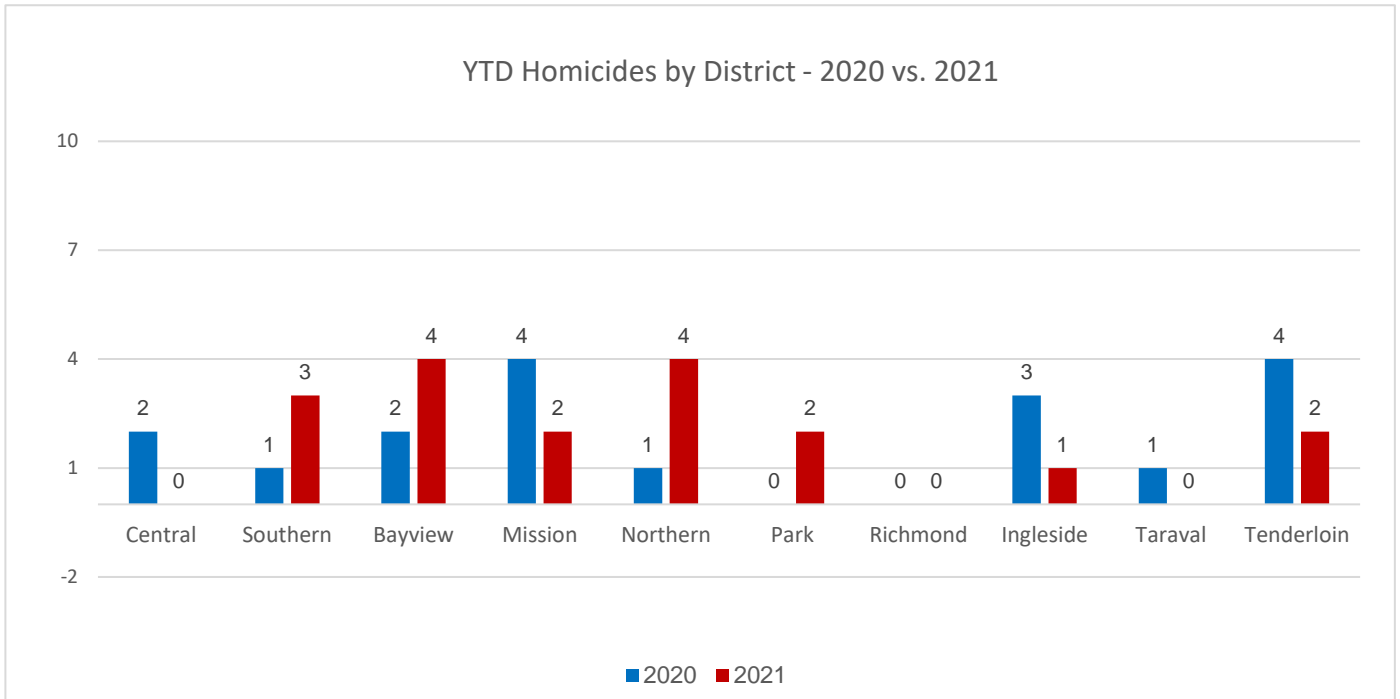
GUN VIOLENCE – Is UP 150% compared to 2020

- **There were 4 shooting incidents causing injuries to 5 individuals for the week ending on 05/30/21**
 - There are a total of **73 incidents** resulting in **95 victims** YTD
- **There were NO homicides the week ending on 05/30/2021**
 - There are **18 homicides** YTD
 - There were **6 homicides** in May
 - There were **3 homicides** in April
 - **8** of the **18** cases are cleared; **7** cleared by arrest, **1** cleared by exceptional = 44% Clearance YTD
