

Good Samaritans award

Summary of the incident:

On 4/12/19 at 1224 hours, Dispatch received a call regarding a kidnapping at Market/Noe St. Victim (two years old) was walking next to his mother, who was pushing the stroller, east on 17th St, when the suspect approached from behind and picked up the victim and began to walk in the opposite direction. Victim's mother turned around and ran after the suspect for a couple of feet. The Victim's mother then grabbed onto the suspect with one hand and the victim with the other. The mother was then able to pull victim back into her arms. The suspect then fled.

Due to the mother screaming for help, several bystanders came to the mother's assistance. The suspect then fled west on 17th St and the bystanders (Good Samaritans) gave chase for several blocks until they were able to detain the suspect until the police arrived.

The names and action of each good Samaritans:

Adam Walker: Gave chase to the suspect and caught him. He held the suspect until the police arrived.

[REDACTED]: Photographed the incident and gave chase of the suspect and remained at the scene.

[REDACTED]: Remained at the scene to comfort the victim and called 911.

[REDACTED]: gave chase to the suspect and helped detain the suspect until the police arrived. [REDACTED] also called 911.

The suspect lives in Western Australia and arrived in San Francisco on Wednesday after visiting Hawaii.
