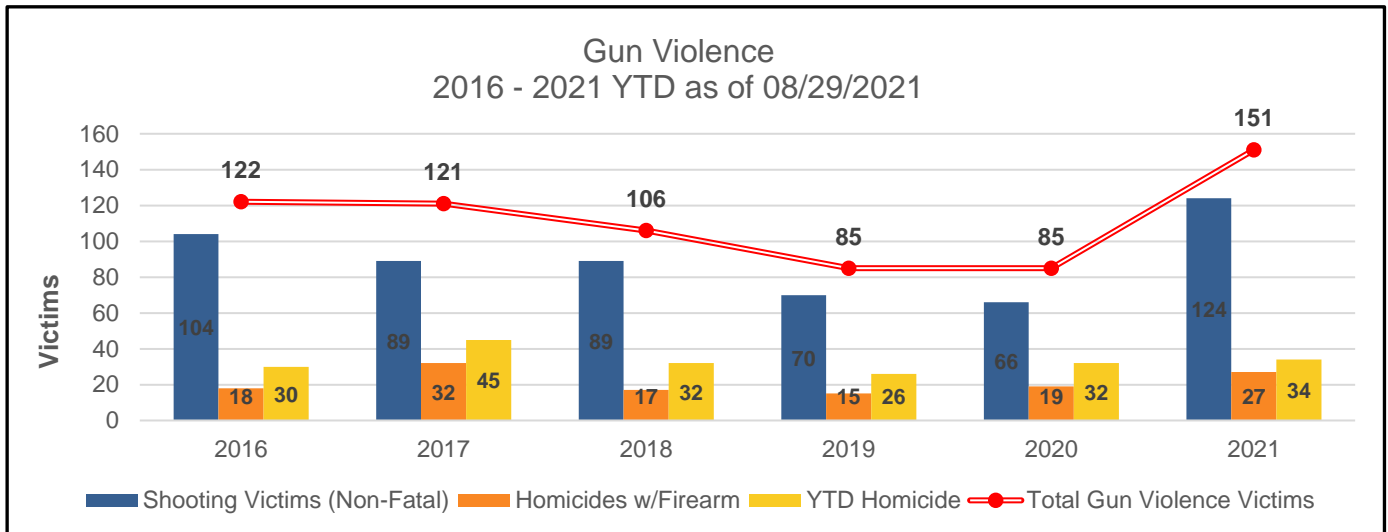

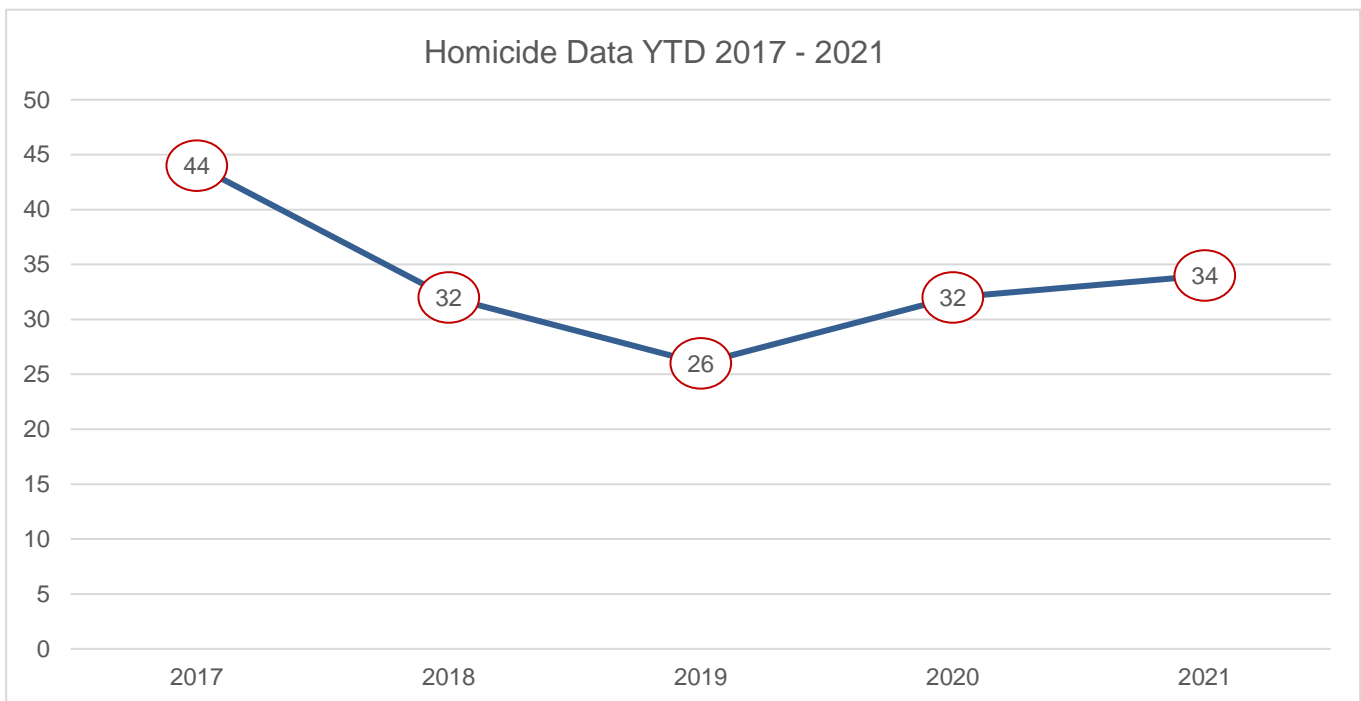
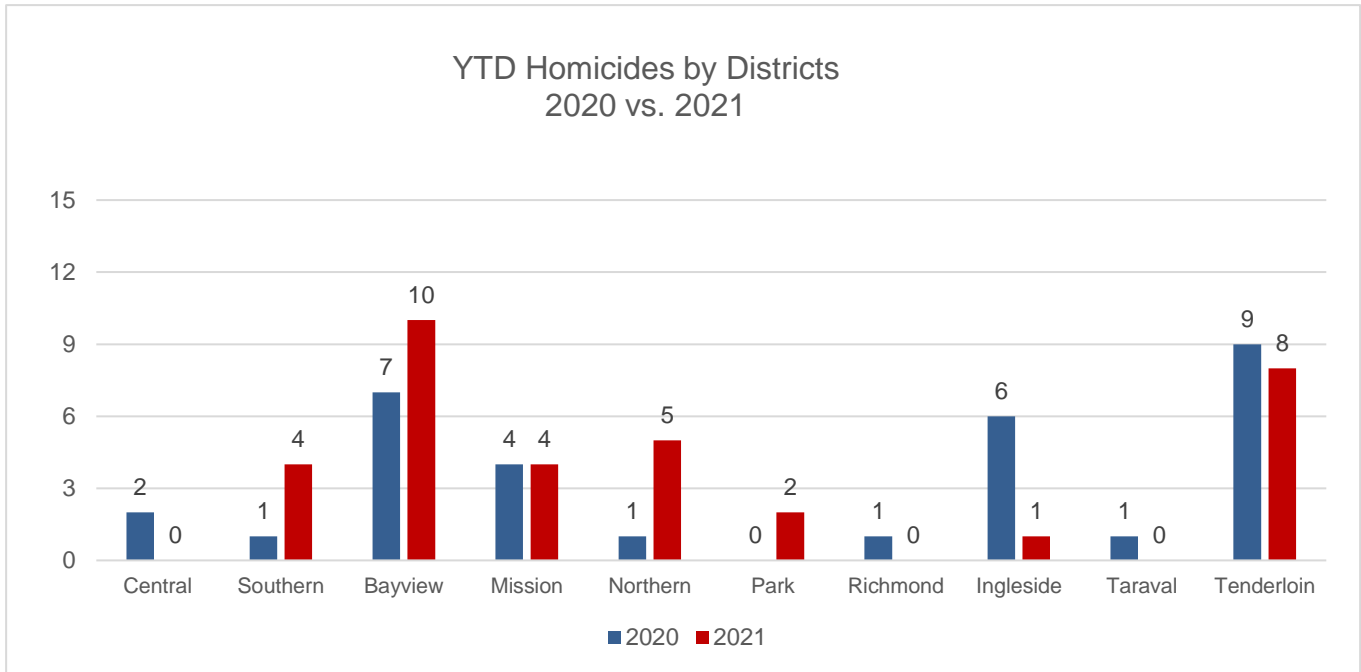
GUN VIOLENCE – Is UP 78% compared to 2020

- There were **NO** shooting incidents for the week ending on 08/29/21
 - There are a total of **124** incidents resulting in **151** victims YTD
- There were **NO** homicides the week ending on 08/29/2021
 - There are **34** homicides YTD
 - There are **4** homicides in August
 - There were **6** homicides in July
 - **Overall Clearance Rate: 92%**
