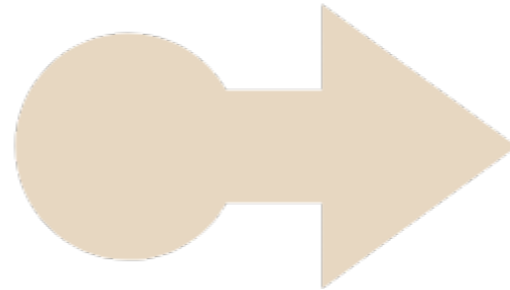

■ Body Worn Camera Access

SFPD cannot allow direct access because there may be inadvertent CLETS material that must be redacted

Possible Solutions for Direct Access:

1. State legislation to designate Civilian Oversight bodies as law enforcement agencies or
2. Have DOJ authorize direct access and deem it not to be violative of CJIS

Possible Solution without Direct Access

1. DPA obtains Evidence.com license to facilitate sharing with SFPD
