This agreement has been held up as a national model. Since its implementation police shootings have gone down and police accountability has gone up. For decades our communities have demanded our leaders hold police accountable when they abuse their power. Now, we once again call on our leaders to prevent the erosion of meaningful progress. We have come too far to turn back now.
