Standardized Population Figure

(Supersedes DB 17-066)

In order to establish a standard and uniform figure for resident and daytime population for the City of San Francisco for use by the Department, a population estimate based on data provided by the U.S. Census Bureau, the San Francisco Travel Association, and the Bay Area Metropolitan Transportation Commission/Association of Bay Area Governments has been adopted.

Official San Francisco Police Department Population Estimates:

1. Tourists: 68,998 average per day

2. Commuters: 260,217
