Exygy created a unified pattern library for a series of multiple tech hubs across the world, built in Drupal. These hubs include <http://digital.nyc> and <http://starthub.org>. Similarly, Exygy created a pattern library for the SF DAHLIA affordable housing portal. The DAHLIA pattern library could be easily adapted for use in Drupal themes. With Exygy's help, CCSF could begin adopting a unified pattern library across different City departments, even across different platforms.

QUESTION 2 - Briefly describe your process and deliverables involved in building themes for Drupal solutions. Focus on how your firm would reconcile the specific design needs of a City agency with a broader set of City enterprise requirements.

A pattern library is a collection of user interface design patterns - recurring solutions that solve common design problems. For example, 18F and USDS have published the US Web Design Standards. There is a San Francisco pattern library that Exygy has launched as part of the affordable housing project (please see above). This locally used pattern library is a free and open design system which would enable additional City agencies to start from a strong San Francisco-blessed brand.

Using the pattern library approach outlined above, Exygy designs and builds responsive, mobile friendly website design systems. Exygy also excels in website accessibility. In 2013 Exygy built Benetech.org to rigorous accessibility standards, in partnership with Knowbility, a 501(c)3 that supports the independence and empowerment of people with disabilities by promoting the use and improving the availability of accessible information technology. The site was built using a Straightforward design with ARIA landmarks, Layout and font resizing, Effective color contrast, Alt-text tags, Multimedia Descriptions and Captions and Descriptive hypertext links. Our software development & testing methodology mirrors industry-wide best practices, including git version control and multiple server environments for development, testing, and production. We often work with managed hosting providers such as those being solicited for response in this RFP, who make it easy to run multiple environments. We follow an Agile development methodology. We have trained client staff by inviting them to pair with our designers and/or engineers on Agile sprints, including engineers at the SF Department of Technology.

Drupal includes robust user account types and access control systems. This allows us to create and implement a custom services workflow for the updating of content. This workflow and editorial process should be generalized to meet the needs of a typical agency, while customized to meet the specific needs of each City agency. This process will be developed throughout the content strategy work and implemented during engineering sprints.

Using a pattern-library based approach (described above), we craft drupal solutions that are responsive and mobile friendly. We engage in responsive testing throughout the theme development process. Our security practices include relying heavily on best practices and approaches in partnership with managed cloud hosts. We and our hosting partners ensure that Drupal itself stays updated on all production machines. We leverage Drupal's built in authentication, integrate securely with third party authentication systems, and employ cloud-based security and defense measures, such as IP screening using Fastly, a cloud-based caching service.
