



Hotspot 2.0 Guide For Apple iOS 7+ Devices

The screenshots shown are taken from an Apple iPhone; however, the process is similar for an Apple iPad and Mac Computer.

1. Locate the "Settings" icon and press it.



2. Click on the "Wi-Fi" tab under "Settings".



3. If your Wi-Fi settings have been turned "Off", swipe the button to the right to scan for available Wi-Fi connections.





- Find “_San_Francisco_Free_WiFi” in the list of networks and click the network name to connect.



- Once the connection is established, a blue checkmark displays next to “_San_Francisco_Free_WiFi”.

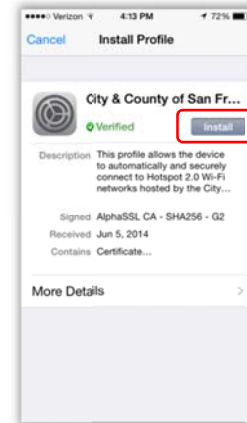


- Your phone will automatically display the “Log In” screen. Click the “Continue With Secure Wi-Fi” button.





7. The “Install Profile” screen will be displayed. Click the “Install” button to install the profile.



8. The “CONSENT” screen will be displayed. Click “Install” to complete the profile installation.



9. The “Profile Installed” screen will be displayed with a successful installation. Press “Done” to continue.





10. The “Profile” screen will be displayed showing the “City and County of San Francisco” profile. Click on “General” to continue.



11. The Wi-Fi Settings screen will show the “SFGov_Secure” network connection as established with a blue checkmark displayed next to it.



12. You are now securely connected to the San Francisco Hotspot 2.0 Wi-Fi service.
